Confession and Forgiveness

March typically aligns with the Christian season of Lent, in which we are called to repent and spiritually prepare for the celebration of Easter and Christ's resurrection. Here are some Bible verses about confessing our sins and forgiving others. I ask you to read and study these during the month of March.

March 1-*"From that time Jesus began to preach, saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."* ~ Matthew 4:17

March 2-"*The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.*" ~ 2 Peter 3:9

March 3-"Repent therefore, and turn again, that your sins may be blotted out" ~ Acts 3:19

March 4-"No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish." ~ Luke 13:3

March 5-"And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." ~ Acts 2:38

March 6-"*The times of ignorance God overlooked, but now he commands all people everywhere to repent*" ~ Acts 17:30

March 7-Bear fruit in keeping with repentance. ~ Matthew 3:8

March 8-"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." ~ 1 John 1:9

March 9-"Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working." ~ James 5:16
