NEEDLE SWEEPS AND SHARPS DISPOSAL

- Used sharps can pose serious risk to health, as they can carry highly infectious pathogens such as HIV and Hepatitis B.
- Puncturing the skin by syringe, hypodermic needle, scissors, scalpels, broken glass or knives could potentially cause severe and fatal health complications.
- Sharps must be collected by a professional sharps disposal company and handled with the utmost care, whilst ensuring government guidelines are adhered to.
- We can also provide you with urgent assistance in an emergency should you find used syringes or sharps on your property.
- As a licensed waste disposal company, all materials will be disposed of appropriately and legally.



END OF TENANCY CLEANING

HOARDED HOUSES

It is estimated that 2-5% of the UK population live with hoarding issues - equivalent to 1.2 million households. Hoarding is a recognised mental illness, often originating from childhood experiences, for example living in poverty or emotional and/or physical abuse.

There are three types of hoarding

- 1) Inanimate objects - clothes, newspapers, containers etc, this is the most common form of hoarding.
- 2) Wet hoarding from bodily functions - urine & faeces.
- 3) Animal hoarding, often with the inability to provide minimal standards of care to the animals. Homes are eventually destroyed by the accumulation of animal faeces and infestation of insects.

A multi agency approach is often necessary, including input from Fire Service, adult social care and local authority.

We can assist in the full removal (recommended) and disposal of the hoard, followed by a full decontamination and extensive cleaning to bring the property back to a safe, sanitary liveable condition.
