High School Scholarship Application

Eligibility Requirements

The Jaguar and County Alumni Association Scholarship Fund (Foundation) will award 1-2 scholarship(s) to a Hillcrest High School student. To be considered by the scholarship committee, an application must meet the following requirements:

- * Be an exemplary student. Have or maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- * Be a high school senior eligible to graduate the same year as the scholarship application date.
- * Be currently accepted to an accredited, post-secondary college, or at least have applied for a minimum of two schools.
- * Be a willing participant to one day come back and do something for your community.

Application Procedures

Applicants will be evaluated on a 100-point scale dependent on the criteria listed below. **Only completed and signed applicants will be reviewed** by the scholarship selection committee.

Academic Grade Point Average

(Total of 30 possible points)

The following points are earned based on the applicant's cumulative GPA. Sealed official transcript showing current GPA must be submitted for verification. No duplicate copies will be accepted.

Cumulative GPA 0 – 2.49 = 1 point

Cumulative GPA 2.5 – 2.59 = 2 points

Cumulative GPA 2.6 – 2.79 = 5 points

Cumulative GPA 2.8 – 2.99 = 10 points

Cumulative GPA 3.0 – 3.29 = 15 points

Cumulative GPA 3.3 – 3.59 = 20 points

Cumulative GPA 3.6 – 3.89 = 25 points

Cumulative GPA 3.9 – 4.0 = 30 points

School Participation

(Total of 20 possible points)

Points may be earned for participating in school activities. These activities can range from SGA, 4-H Club, Band, JROTC Spanish Club, and all Sports. For verification, please submit a letter of participation from the head coach or faculty advisor over the activity. Verification letter should include coach/faculty member name, their email address and phone number, dates you've been active, and any special positions that you have held.

4 Activities = 20 points

3 Activities = 15 points

2 Activities = 10 points

1 Activity = 5 points

Jaguar and County Alumni Association Scholarship Fund (Foundation) Activities

(Total of 10 possible points)

Points may be earned by registering and being involved with the Jaguar and County Alumni Association Fund (Foundation) All Class Reunion, Back to Jag, Pageant and 5K Walk-Run.

Pageant & Run = 10 points

Pageant or Run = 7 points

Volunteer for All Class Reunion, Back to Jag, Pageant or run = 4 points

Required Essay

(Total of 25 possible points)

Complete each essay question listed on page 5 of this application. Each question is worth a possible 5 points for a total of 25 points. Answer must be a minimum of 50 words per question. Only typed response will be considered.

Letters of Reference

(Total of 15 possible points)

Submit three letters of recommendation from a teacher in the schooling system, someone in your community, and a leader in your church.

3 Letters = 15 points

2 Letters = 10 points

1 Letter = 5 points

Selection Process

Selection will be based by points on student's overall academic progress, extracurricular activities, foundation involvement, essay questions, and letters of reference.

Notice of Award

Student will be notified by mail and phone call of the award of fiscal year scholarship.

Scholarship Deadline

Return scholarship package into your counselor no later than **April 30, 2026**.
