
JAC 2026 Point System Overview

The JAC Point System is designed to encourage alumni engagement and reward classes for active participation throughout the year. Points earned by each class will contribute to overall standings and recognition at major events. Below is a detailed guide on how your class can earn points.

1. Annual Senate Check-In (10 Points)

- Complete the **Jotform link** posted in the Facebook group.
 - Confirm whether your current Senators will remain or if new ones will take over.
 - If your Senators remain the same but you need to update contact info, select “Yes, to make CHANGE” to update details.
 - **Points:**
 - Completing the form = **10 points per senate/per class (max of 20 points)**.

2. Senator Financial Status

- Senators are the backbone of JAC.
 - If your class Senators become financial members:
 - **Financial Senator = 30 points per class** (instead of 20 for regular financial members).

3. All Class Reunion (ACR) Registration

- There are **37 graduating classes** (including 2026).
 - Maximum points: **20 points** for the first class to register.
 - Points decrease by 1 for each subsequent class until the 18th class.
 - Classes registering 18th and beyond = **1 point**.
- Example:**
- 1st class = 20 pts
 - 2nd class = 19 pts
 - 3rd class = 18 pts ...
 - 18th class onward = 1 pt.

4. Financial Membership

- Each financial member in your class = **20 points**.
 - Each lifetime member = **25 points**.

✓ 5. Quarterly Meetings

- For each Senator attending = **10 points**.
- For each financial member attending = **2 points**.
- **Open Meeting (once per year):**
 - Each first-time attendee or unregistered classmate = **1 point**.

✓ 6. ACR Softball Tournament

- Classes will be grouped into 5 teams.
- Participation = **5 points per member of representing class**.
 - Each team is represented by 2 classmates from each class. If your class decides not to participate and another class fills in for them, points will still be awarded to that class for participation.
- Winning team bonuses:
 - 1st place = **15 points**
 - 2nd place = **9 points**
 - 3rd place = **5 points**
 - 4th place = **2 points**.
 - 5th place = **1 point**.
- Team Captain bonuses:
 - Captain = **10 points for each Team Captain**.
 - Responsible for coordination of team and completing team roster.
 - Will receive the team trophy to take home if team wins overall.

✓ 7. Annual Toy Drive

- Points based on gift value:
 - Small gift (\$1–\$10) = **1 point**
 - Medium gift (\$11–\$30) = **3 points**
 - Large gift (\$31–\$99) = **5 points**
 - Major gift/bike (\$100+) = **10 points**
 - Corporate Sponsorship = **15 points**
 - Bulk Donations = **15–25 points** (depending on amount).

✓ 8. Scholarship Fundraiser

- Your classmates can donate to this fundraiser throughout the year.

Points based on donation amount:

- \$1–\$10 = **1 point**
- \$11–\$20 = **2 points**
- \$21–\$30 = **3 points**
- \$31–\$40 = **4 points**
- \$41–\$50 = **5 points**
- \$51–\$60 = **6 points**
- \$61–\$70 = **7 points**
- \$71–\$80 = **8 points**
- \$81–\$90 = **9 points**
- \$91–\$99 = **10 points**

Starting at \$100, points increase by 5 points for every \$10 increment:

- \$100–\$110 = **11 points**
- \$111–\$120 = **16 points**
- \$121–\$130 = **21 points**
- \$131–\$140 = **26 points**
- \$141–\$150 = **31 points**

(... continues up to \$500 following the same pattern)
