


Eagle Run Trails

- Fee Site for Access
- Fishing Access
- Restrooms

Multi-Season Trail System along the banks of the AuSable River, you will find the Eagle Run Trails. This 4.2-mile loop, maintained by dedicated volunteers, is a tranquil spot for hiking, fat biking, snowshoeing, and cross-country skiing with scenic views in a beautiful natural setting.



RECOMMENDED AuSable River Trips

Short Trip-Whirlpool to the Lake

- Half Day 2-3 hours
- 6 river miles

Inside Notes/Tip: This 6-mile float should take about 2-3 hours without any serious paddling. Just the perfect length for a relaxing float. Area outfitters provide you with any paddling gear needed, drop you off at Whirlpool, and you have to do it on your own. If you want to add on some time, start at #13 Lower Power Dam and you will also enjoy an hour or so of the lake to town, and won't need to paddle.

Full Day- Foote Dam Pond Paddle

- Full Day 5-7 hours
- 18.5 river miles

Inside Notes/Tip: Making your way from Lower Coles Dam through the Foote Dam Pond to Lake Huron is an 18.5-mile paddle that should take approximately 7 hours. The passage at Foote Dam is a narrow, prime stopping point for lunch before finishing the final leg of your journey.

Top Floats along the AuSable River: We asked the experts to help us pinpoint the best launch spots for planning paddling trips of various lengths. No matter the scale of your adventure, the 94 miles of AuSable River can provide the perfect destination. If you don't have your own watercraft, let one of our area outfitters provide the gear.

Full Day Trip or Overnight on the middle AuSable

- Full Day 5-6.5 hours
- 15.0 river miles

Inside Notes/Tip: This 15-mile river float should take about 5-6.5 hours without any serious paddling. Just the perfect length for a relaxing float. Area outfitters provide you with any paddling gear needed, drop you off at Whirlpool, and you have to do it on your own. If you want to add on some time, start at #13 Lower Power Dam and you will also enjoy an hour or so of the lake to town, and won't need to paddle.

Quick Overnight Trip

- Quick Overnight Trip
- 18.0 river miles

Inside Notes/Tip: This 18-mile river float should take about 5-6.5 hours without any serious paddling. Just the perfect length for a relaxing float. Area outfitters provide you with any paddling gear needed, drop you off at Whirlpool, and you have to do it on your own. If you want to add on some time, start at #13 Lower Power Dam and you will also enjoy an hour or so of the lake to town, and won't need to paddle.

Float on the upper AuSable

- Half Day 2.5-4 hours
- 8.0-13 river miles

Inside Notes/Tip: Great trips on the upper AuSable from the convenience of launching in Dismantling Cragging. The quick trip takes you to Burton's Landing, and the longer trip to Saultville Landing.

You could also extend your trip to a full-day by making your way down to Wilkes Landing or Canoe's Raft, but you may want to opt for an overnight as this will be a full 8+ hours on the river.

In 2018, the Iosco Bikes and Trails Group envisioned a single-track mountain bike trail that would provide an expedition through the Huron National Forest. Following the contour of the AuSable River, 44 miles of trails are planned for development between Old Orchard Campground and Cooke Dam Road. The Wildcat features sections full of exciting rollers and challenging climbs with rewarding views. **Access the trailhead at the Foote Site Overlook** off River Road to experience the beginning phase of this exciting trail. The trail is open year-round, and when the snow flies it will be groomed for fat biking.
