

## 25 Scriptures on Wisdom

**Proverbs 4:7** — Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding.

**James 1:5** — If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

**Proverbs 2:6** — For the LORD giveth wisdom: out of his mouth cometh knowledge and understanding.

**Ecclesiastes 7:12** — For wisdom is a defence, and money is a defence: but the excellency of knowledge is, that wisdom giveth life to them that have it.

**Proverbs 9:10** — The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.

**Colossians 2:3** — In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

**Proverbs 3:13** — Happy is the man that findeth wisdom, and the man that getteth understanding.

**Job 28:28** — And unto man he said, Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom; and to depart from evil is understanding.

**Proverbs 16:16** — How much better is it to get wisdom than gold! and to get understanding rather to be chosen than silver!

**Daniel 2:21** — He giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding.

**Psalms 111:10** — The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do his commandments.

**Proverbs 19:20** — Hear counsel, and receive instruction, that thou mayest be wise in thy latter end.

**1 Corinthians 1:25** — Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

**Proverbs 8:11** — For wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it.

**Ecclesiastes 2:26** — For God giveth to a man that is good in his sight wisdom, and knowledge, and joy.

**Proverbs 11:2** — When pride cometh, then cometh shame: but with the lowly is wisdom.

**James 3:17** — But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated.

**Proverbs 15:33** — The fear of the LORD is the instruction of wisdom; and before honour is humility.

**Psalms 90:12** — So teach us to number our days, that we may apply our hearts unto wisdom.

**Proverbs 24:14** — So shall the knowledge of wisdom be unto thy soul: when thou hast found it, then there shall be a reward.

**Luke 2:52** — And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.

**Proverbs 18:15** — The heart of the prudent getteth knowledge; and the ear of the wise seeketh knowledge.

**Ecclesiastes 10:10** — Wisdom is profitable to direct.

**1 Kings 3:12** — Lo, I have given thee a wise and an understanding heart.

**Proverbs 13:20** — He that walketh with wise men shall be wise: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed.
