LENTEN DAILY READER 2014: The Heart in the Psalms and the New Testament: An Introduction

I have long been intrigued with the affirmation that Christians should acquire a "biblical mind." Yet, though I've been intrigued I also have not really known how to do that, how to acquire such a mind that allows us not just to interpret passages of Scripture in isolation as we read or hear them, but how to interpret them in the context of other Scripture passages: how to think intuitively or "naturally" about the Scriptures.

So over the past few years I have considered how to encourage both you and me to learn how to read the Scriptures in broader ways. We began with the *E100 Plan*—blasting through the whole Bible with 100 "essential" passages. Last Great Lent we worked through particular readings from the Prophecy of Isaiah and the Epistle to the Hebrews—both of which are particularly assigned by the Orthodox Church for Lenten reflection (historically, also meant as being important for the preparation of catechumens, for those who would be entering the Church through Baptism).

This year we are going to consider a particular word or concept, the "heart," and try to acquire supporting vocabulary. I began by assembling all references to the "heart" in the entire Bible — which turned out to be over 900 verses, and then reducing those to what are key definitions or summaries as found in the Psalms and throughout the New Testament. There are 200 verses in all, 5 assigned for each of the 40 days of Great Lent.

I've attached as Word and PDF files all of the readings and there are hard copies by the candlestand. I will also send out each day's reading the night before by email. I encourage you to keep a log, journal, or notes on the various ways and images that are used within these passages. They will form the basis for sermons, emails, and articles in *Crossroads* throughout Great Lent. The readings will start on the official first day of Great Lent: Monday March 3 and end on Friday April 11 (the eve of Lazarus Saturday).

In addition, we will supplement our Biblical foundation with passages from:

- 1) Archimandrite Zacharias, The Hidden Man of the Heart: The Cultivation of the Heart in Orthodox Christian Anthropology
- 2) Pseudo-Macarius, "The Fifty Spiritual Homilies"
- 3) The writings of Metropolitan Kallistos Ware

In fact, let's allow Metropolitan Kallistos to introduce us to this exploration. It comes from his "Preface" to *Pseudo-Macarius: The Fifty Spiritual Homilies*, (Paulist Press, 1992), xv-xvii.

The heart designates the human person as a whole, regarded as a spiritual subject. It is the ground or core of our being, the "inner self" (Eph. 3:16-17) — what in Zen Buddhism is termed "the center of the lotus." It is at the same time the place where we come face to face with God, where the grace of the Spirit is active (Roman 8:27; Gal 4:6). Once the heart is understood in this comprehensive way, it is surprising how many scriptural texts acquire sharper significance. When, for instance, it is said, "The heart is deep" (Ps 64:6) — a key text in Orthodox spirituality — the meaning is that the human person as a whole is a profound mystery. The divine appeal, "My child, give me your heart" (Proverbs 23:26), affirms that we are to entrust to God our entire being. By the same token, when the Hesychasts of the Christian East (spiritual fathers) speak about "prayer of the heart," they have in mind prayer of the total person—spirit, soul, and body.

Macarius, for his part clearly understands the heart in this all-embracing biblical sense:

The heart itself is but a small vessel, yet dragons are there, and there are also lions; there are poisonous beasts and all the treasures of evil. There also are rough and uneven roads; there are precipices. But there too is God, the angels, the life and the Kingdom, the light and the apostles, the heavenly cities and the treasures of grace—all things are there.

"There are infinite depths to the human heart," Macarius states elsewhere. While denoting the physical organ located in our chest, it is clearly a symbol of much more than this, existing as it does as a whole series of interconnected levels:

- 1. The heart is first of all the central and controlling element in our physical structure: "The heart directs and governs all the other organs of the body." When the heart ceases to function, bodily death ensues.
- 2. The heart is likewise the place in which the intellect is situated: "For there, in the heart, the mind (nous) abides as well as all the thoughts of the soul and all its hopes." In Macarius's symbolic scheme, there is no dichotomy between head and heart: we think with our heart.
- 3. The heart includes what we today designate as "the unconscious," whether personal or collective.
- 4. As moral center, the heart is the point where grace and sin are experienced: "There is found the office of justice and of injustice. There is death and there is life."
- 5. The heart is in this way also the point of self-transcendence, where we encounter God. It is the "palace of Christ," where he "sets up his kingdom."

Through the heart, then, divine grace permeates our entire personhood, not only transforming the soul but penetrating also "throughout all parts of the body." The heart is the symbol of our personal unity, the center where the physical and non-material, the created and the uncreated converge. It is the point of meeting:

between body and soul; / between the unconscious and the conscious; between human freedom and divine grace.

FROM THE PSALMS

DAY 1: MONDAY MARCH 3

Be angry, and do not sin. Meditate within your heart on your bed, and be still.

So God, who knows the **heart**, acknowledged them by giving them the Holy Spirit, just as *He did* to us,
