Have mercy upon us, Lord; *have mercy upon us! v: To You I lift up my eyes, for You are enthroned in the heavens!

Troparion Tone 1

By raising Lazarus from the dead before Your passion, You confirmed the universal resurrection, O Christ God. Like the children with the palms of victory, We cry out to You, O Vanquisher of Death: Hosanna in the highest! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord.

Kontakion *Tone* 2

Christ—the Joy, the Truth, and the Light of all, the Life of the World and the Resurrection—has appeared in His goodness, to those on earth. He has become the Image of our Resurrection, granting divine forgiveness to all.

Prokeimenon Tone 3

The Lord is my light and my Savior! Whom shall I fear?

v. The Lord is the defender of my life. Of whom shall I be afraid?

Monday April 25 – Holy Week – Monday Sixth Hour

Troparion of the Prophecy *Tone 6*

With humbled hearts we fall before You, and we pray to You, the Savior of the world: for You are the God// of those who repent.

Prokeimenon *Tone 4* (*Psalm 125*)

When the Lord turns back * the captivity of His people. v: Then our lips will be filled with joy!

The Reading from the Prophecy of Ezekiel 1: 1-20

Prokeimenon Tone 4 (Psalm 126)

Unless the Lord builds the house * those who build it labor in vain. v: Unless the Lord watches over the city, the watchman stays awake in vain.

Forgive exceedingly those who have sinned without measure, Savior! Enable us blamelessly to worship Your holy Resurrection, through the intercessions of Your most pure Mother,// O merciful One!

Prokeimenon of the Prophecy *Tone* 5 (*Psalm* 129)

For with the Lord there is mercy * and with Him is plenteous redemption! v: Out of the depths have I cried to You, O Lord; Lord, hear my voice!

Reading from the Prophecy of Ezekiel 1:21 - 2:1

Prokeimenon *Tone 4* (*Psalm 130*)

Let Israel trust in the Lord * henceforth and forevermore!

v: Lord, my heart is not lifted up; my eyes are not raised too high!

Wednesday April 27—Holy Week—Wednesday Sixth Hour

Troparion of the Prophecy *Tone 8*

Today, the evil assembly has gathered and plots against You.

Today Judas received condemnation from the agreement:

Caiaphas confesses unknowingly.

For the sake of all You will accept death freely;//

Christ God, our Redeemer: Glory to You!

Prokeimenon of the Prophecy *Tone* 4 (*Psalm* 133)

The Lord will bless You from Zion * He Who made heaven and earth.

v: Behold now, bless the Lord, all you servants of the Lord!

Reading from the Prophecy of Ezekiel 2:3 - 3:3

Prokeimenon *Tone 6* (*Psalm 134*)

Bless the Lord * you who fear the Lord.

v: Praise the Name of the Lord; servants, praise the Lord!
