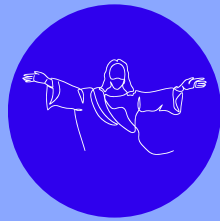

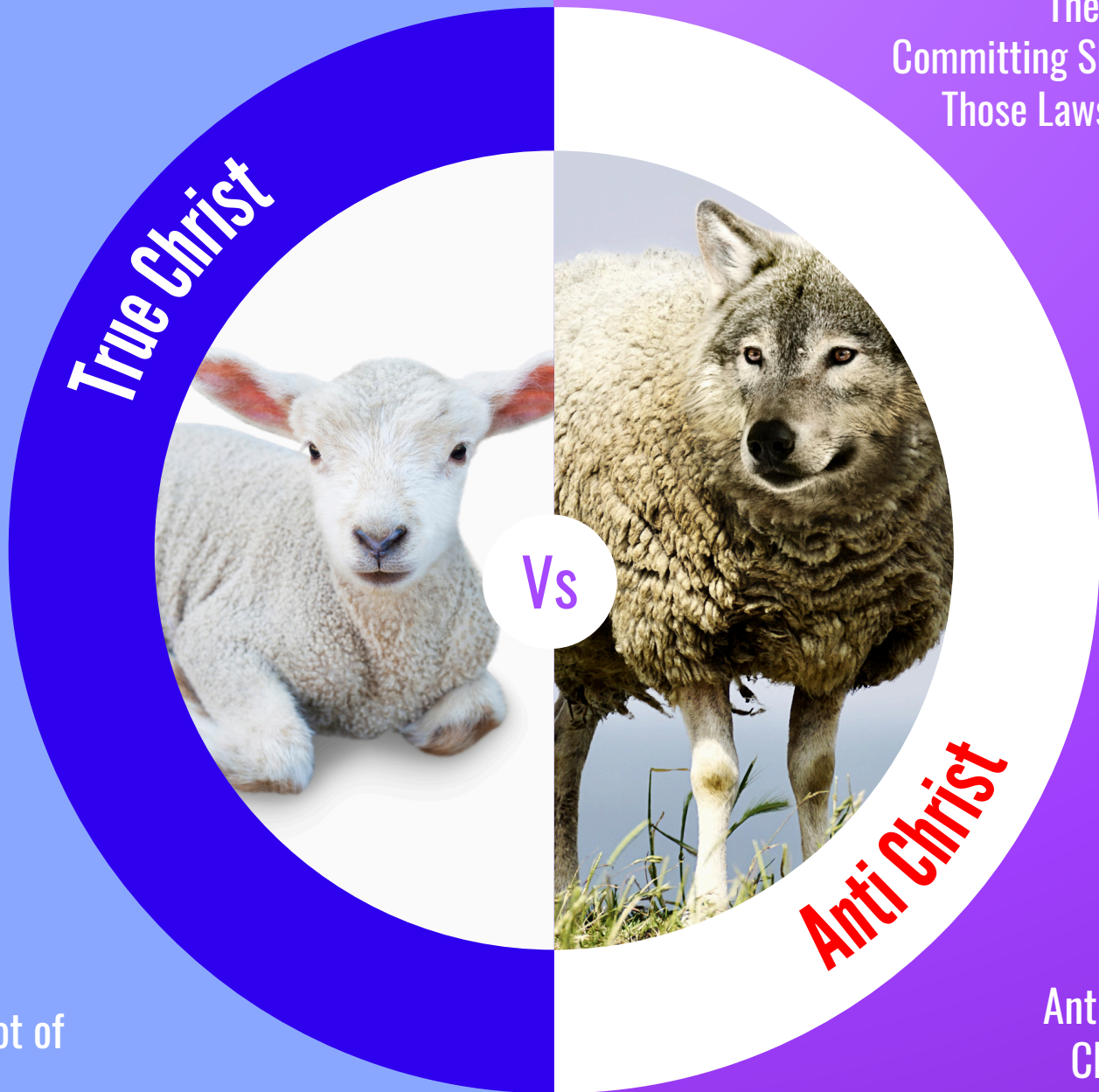

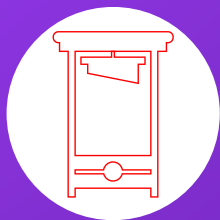

"In consequence of continual transgression, the **MORAL LAW** was **REPEATED** in awful grandeur from Sinai. **CHRIST** gave to Moses **religious precepts** which were **to GOVERN** the everyday life. These **STATUTES** were explicitly given **to GUARD the Ten Commandments**. They were **NOT shadowy types to pass away WITH the death of Christ**. They were to be **BINDING UPON MAN IN EVERY AGE AS LONG AS TIME SHOULD LAST**. These **COMMANDS** were **ENFORCED** by the **POWER** of the **MORAL LAW**, and they clearly and definitely explained that law." (Review & Herold, 1875, par. 10) Now you may ask, what does the moral law include? Do they only include the Ten Commandments? Looking at the statement above, we can see that whatever law is considered "law" and "religious precepts," they were to guard the ten commandments. So, apparently there is **more to the "moral law" than just the ten commandments**. This was **written before the 1888** General Conference, which is when A. T. Jones and E. J. Waggoner presented this same point. **Antichrist** wants humanity to **rid themselves** of the **Levitical Law**, at the **time of Christ's death**, so we can **accumulate sins without** feeling the need to **repent of them**.
