CERT TRAINING

April 28, 29, and 30, 2023

The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Program is presented by Costa Mesa Fire & Rescue and is designed for the citizen responder. The CERT course prepares and teaches community members to become better prepared for emergencies, how to suppress small fires, assist with medical emergencies, November conduct light search & rescue and how to organize people and resources before, during and after a major disaster. There is no fee to attend this program other than your commitment of time and effort.

In the event of a major emergency, Volunteers with CERT training may also assist local public safety officials. CERT graduates are registered as Disaster Service Workers and are protected under CA State Worker's Compensation guidelines while training or assisting during a disaster. The City of Costa Mesa is dedicated to creating a strong CERT program. CERT members meet the 2nd Thursday of the month to practice and learn new skills.
