

Illness Policy Covid-19 Response/ Procedure #4982

The home is the first line of defense in protecting the children. It is important that you keep your child home if they are not feeling well and/or experiencing symptoms. Symptoms may include:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Persistence running nose

All students will have their temperatures checked via a touch free thermometer when dropped off, whether at daycare or at the classroom. Students with temperature will be sent home and must be fever free for 24 hours before returning to class. If a student tests positive for COVID-19, notify the school at once and follow doctor's orders. **A negative test will need to be provided to return to class.**

Parents will be notified if a student or teacher tests positive in your child's classroom. The classroom will be closed for a minimum of 48 hours to thoroughly sanitize and classes will be taught virtually during this period. Sanitizing Foggers will be released.

Classrooms will be cleaned and sanitized daily, more often as needed.

Common areas will be cleaned and sanitized daily, more often as needed.

Sanitizer stations will be in place throughout the classroom

Air Purifiers are turned on nightly
