#### ACADEMIC SELF-PAY

\$8800 (paid in full) or \$735 (monthly over 12 months)

• Full-time enrollment. Includes all classes.

#### CO-ENROLL WITH CONNECTIONS OR IDEA

Apx. \$6200 (paid in full) or \$520 (monthly over 12 months)

- Connections or IDEA allotment can be used towards mathematics, language, and electives.
- Family is responsible for co-enrollment paperwork and deadlines with Connections or IDEA.

#### HOMESCHOOL PARTNERSHIP - UPPER SCHOOL

Bible & Humanities - \$3500 (paid in full) or \$350 (monthly over 10 months)

• This course offers 2.5 hours of in-person instruction Mon-Thur and 1.5 hours on Friday.

Science or Math - \$1400 (paid in full) or \$140 (monthly over 10 months)

• These courses are taught by in-person and/or online teachers and meet four or five times weekly.

Latin or Logic - \$1200 (paid in full) or \$120 (monthly over 10 months)

• These courses are taught by in-person and/or online teachers. Latin and Logic meet twice weekly.

Electives - \$800 (paid in full) or \$80 (monthly over 10 months)

• See side bar. Offered on Friday afternoons.

## **ELEMENTARY PROGRAM**

\$1920 (paid in full) or \$240 (monthly over 8 months)

• Instruction in Science, Grammar & Writing, Latin, Music, & Geography.
