

Welcome to Roadhaven!





We are home to two cottages, Rose & Honeysuckle, each with a lower and upper suite. Our property can sleep up to 14 people as a whole, but we welcome folks for any width or length of stay!

THE ALEXANDER SUITE

Our one-bedroom loft boasts 350 sq ft., bright natural light, and a queen bed. We offer a twin pull-out sofa, allowing up to 3 to sleep comfortably. The Alexander is located on the upper level of the Honeysuckle Cottage.

THE DUDLEY SUITE

Our two-bedroom option for those traveling together. Up to 4 guests can stay in this lower-level suite within the Honeysuckle Cottage. Amenities include a private patio, kitchenette, and 550 sq. ft of relaxation. We offer a queen bed, and a trundle twin.





THE ELIZABETH SUITE

Our romantic Elizabeth Suite rests on the lower level of the Rose Cottage and includes a private patio, sweet floral wallpaper, and a breakfast nook. Ideal for two travelers.

THE RUBY SUITE

Our one-bedroom suite boasts 300 sq ft., a view overlooking our garden, and a queen bed. We offer a twin add-on allowing 3 to sleep comfortably. The Ruby Suite is located on the upper level of the Rose Cottage.



CHECK IN

CHECK-IN AFTER 3PM

When you arrive, please park in the visitor parking and make your way to the main house. The cottages are located through a white gate to the right of the main house. We offer contactless entry with a coded key box! We are also typically on site if you'd like a welcome wagon. We understand everyone has their own preference!

While our address says 355 Orchard Drive, you actually reach the property by taking a left or right (depending on what direction you are coming from) onto Mill Creek Drive. Then take an immediate right onto the property. You should see the first sign as you approach Mill Creek Drive and the second sign is at the beginning of the driveway.

BACKYARD HAVEN

We want our backyard recreation area to be fun for the whole family. We have a ton of games such as a life size checkers and chess, tetherball, corn hole, ladder golf, Yardzee, badminton/volleyball, croquet, Connect 4, tic-tac-toe, and even a giant stage to play charades! Remember, please explore and play at your own risk.

FIRE PIT INSTRUCTIONS

The automatic lights go off 2 hours after sundown. The fire pit is easy to operate: Take off top lid, open side door, and turn on gas on the top of the tank knob. Give it about 30 seconds before turning the knob on the side. It will take a second or two to catch fire. When you are done, please turn off the side knob first, then TURN OFF the knob of the gas, and put the lid on.

BLUETOOTH SPEAKERS: LET'S JAM!

To turn ON the speakers, walk to the back of the house and locate the automatic timer, it will be set to 4 hrs, turn knob to say "ON", this gives power to the pavilion. Please turn back to 4 hours when done. The on/off button is at the back of the speaker, make sure the button is down towards blue tape. Once on, look at your Bluetooth and find "PYLE" the PW: oooo.





OUR HISTORY



THE ROOTS OF ROADHAVEN

Roadhaven1830 was originally known as the 'Casper Bowman Home Farm' and while we now sit atop 7 acres, the property was once several hundred acres and home to the largest dairy farm in the area. Prior to 1853, Levi Rinker would use a fulling mill dam to create felt, ruins of which still exist on site. By 1859, he had deeded the property to George Fitzmoyer who, in turn, willed it to his brother William. This led to William's daughter, Rebecca Fitzmoyer Bowman, buying out her siblings to purchase the home (we love a little girl power). Upon her death in 1923, the estate was passed to Casper Bowman, her son, and longest proprietor, who lived here until his death in 1953.

In 1970, the home was purchased by Martin Flinn Tilley, a creative from California, who began its restoration. After Mr. Tilley, came the "Widow's Kip", Rosemary Kip, who had worked for the Sulgrave Club, a private women's only club on D.C.'s Embassy Row (sensing the girl power theme, again!). In 1986, she converted the home into a Bed & Breakfast, complete with 10 modern bathrooms. The previous 'hen house' and 'wash house' were converted into the guest cottages we know and love today.

In 1991, Bob & Betty Luse saw the property listed in the New York Times. They kept the name 'Widow Kip's' and remained for the next 29 years, calling Mount Jackson home. After losing Betty, Bob was ready to sell and so, in 2020, he passed the property to the Nossal family and it was dubbed the Family Farmhouse Inn. Until 2025, when it went through yet another (and ideally final) rebranding to become Roadhaven1830.



Today, Roadhaven1830 is owned by Olivia R. Hilton, who purchased the property for her family to cherish for years to come. Her parents, Rebeccah and David Hilton, will live in the expanded Dudley Suite and help her navigate event hosting, Victorian renovations, and boutique lodging!







PARKING

We offer on-site parking for our guests. You'll find a lower and upper parking area, and you may park on the grass next to the gravel if needed.



TEMPERATURE

Each suite has a wall unit air conditioner and oil-filled radiator for heat. Please note that the heater must have two feet of clearance. Hit the power button in the middle, then use the up and down arrows to achieve the desired temperature.



LOCATION

We are conveniently located ½ mile from downtown Mount Jackson. With convenience, comes a little noise. Due to our proximity to I-81, we have a lovely landscape buffer around the property and white noise machines, if needed.



QUIRKS

To keep your stay cozy, please avoid running the heater and microwave at the same time. If anything trips, just let us know—we'll take care of it!"



SMART TVS

The Smart TV in your room is turned on and off with the Vizio remote. We have Firesticks connected to Youtube TV and you are able to sign in to your own Netflix, Hulu, Apple TV, & other 'smart' accounts.



AMENITIES

Free Wifi, outdoor propane fire pit, swing set for the kiddos, and games for the whole family. Sleep in luxurious cotton bedding with allergy covers and wake up to coffee from the Keurig. With your own mini-fridge and microwave, you will feel right at home. Fishing poles are available for use.



TRASH

No need to worry about taking your trash - we will take care of you! Trashcans are inside each cottage and larger containers are located outside.

- All room rates are based on double occupancy. Each additional person over the initial two guests will be \$15, children under 2 are free. A pack-n-play is available upon request.
- You may cancel 72 hours prior to your check-in time for a full refund.
- Smoking is restricted to outdoor areas, such as under the backyard pavilion. We charge guests a \$100 cleaning fee for smoking indoors.
- Pets are only allowed on a pre-approved, case by case basis.
- We ask that children under 10 be supervised outside. The playset is intended for those under 12 and has a weight limit of 200 lbs.
- Our property is universally accessible, but does not abide by ADA guidelines.
- We know that accidents happen, however, guests will be charged to replace damaged items.

SHENANDOAH CAVERNS

Discover Virginia's most beautiful and unique caverns. Marvel at the beautiful flowstone, stalagmites, stalactites, bacon formations and more! Shenandoah Caverns is the only caverns in Virginia with elevator access. All tours are personally led by knowledgeable guides who cover one mile, in about one hour, in a year-round 56-degree temperature.

AMERICAN CELEBRATION ON PARADE

American Celebration on Parade is one of America's most unique museums and offers an up-close experience with parade floats from famous national celebrations including Presidential Inaugural Parades, the Philadelphia Thanksgiving Day Parade and much more. It's a once-in-a-lifetime, family-friendly, up-close experience that's impossible to describe!

ROUTE 11 POTATO CHIP FACTORY

In 1992, they started with a tiny little cooker, a great recipe, a lot of energy, some good ole fashioned grit, with some twenty-something delusion thrown in for good measure. Now going on 25+ years, the factory is open to the public Mondays — Saturdays, 9am — 5pm. There are big windows in the retail store that allow you to see the entire process, a small gift shop, and chips available for purchase.





LIONS PARK

Lions Park, nestled at 326 Wunder Street, is the Town Park and is home to the Kid's Cove playground and zipline, basketball courts, walking trails (3 loops makes a mile), Town Pool, baseball fields, and picnic shelters.



REDBANKS PARK

The park (coming in 2026) will feature a variety of amenities, including: Easy pedestrian access to the river, a convenient canoe and kayak launch, scenic walking trails, ample parking for visitor, designated picnic areas, and interpretive signage to learn about the local ecology and history.



SEVEN BENDS STATE PARK

Seven Bends State Park is a day-use park located in Woodstock and provides public access to the Shenandoah River, features two hand-carry boat launches, picnic areas, vault restrooms, and 9 miles of hiking trails.



STRASBURG RIVERWALK

The gravel walkway, located along the Shenandoah River, offers beautiful views of the river and the face of the Massanutten Mountain Range called Signal Knob. The .9 mile walk ends at the local high school and three benches and three doggie clean-up stations are located along the walk.

MOUNT JACKSON MUSEUM

Offering an impressive collection of relics from Mount Jackson's days gone by, this museum is dedicated to the historic preservation of the local community. Exhibits include a Civil War Exhibit featuring items collected by the late D. Coiner Rosen, pottery from local folk artist Bill Landis, and wooden handicrafts from Bird Haven, a local community of wood turners in the early 1900s.



VETERANS MEMORIAL

Veterans Park is a place of honor, dedicated to the brave men and women who have served our country. Here, we express our gratitude for their sacrifices and commitment to protecting our freedoms. The park provides a peaceful space for reflection, a place to remember those who served, and a symbol of our community's deep respect for our veterans.



MAYORS PARK

Nestled in the heart of Mount Jackson, Mayors Park is a beloved community gathering spot. This charming park offers a tranquil escape from the hustle and bustle, featuring scenic walking paths, picnic spots under the shade of mature trees, open green space, and community events - check the Town's schedule for more!

UNION CHURCH

The stately Union Church, with its distinctive architecture, has long been a spiritual cornerstone of Mount Jackson. For generations, its doors have welcomed people of all faiths, providing a place for worship, fellowship, and community gatherings. Union Church represents the spirit of unity that binds us together. She was used as a hospital during the War between the States - as highlighted by the soldier graffiti lining the inside walls.

Spanning the North Fork of the Shenandoah River, the iconic Meems Bottom Covered Bridge is more than just a crossing; it's a landmark that embodies the history and charm of Mount Jackson. This covered bridge, with its distinctive design and rustic appeal, is a beloved local treasure. It's a perfect spot for a scenic drive, a leisurely stroll, or capturing a memorable photo. The bridge, at 204 feet (62 m), is the longest covered bridge in Virginia and one of the last that supports regular traffic.

Get outside and explore the County's LOVE signs! There are four located between Mount Jackson, Woodstock & Strasburg - including our very own sign here at Roadhaven!
