Beginning after the first full year of Active Professional membership, a member is required to complete 48 clock hours of continuing education every 4 years for renewal as an Active Professional member of AMTA. Educational programs used to fulfill this requirement must meet the following general description: an organized education experience directly related to massage therapy, which is offered under responsible sponsorship, capable direction and qualified instruction. These may be experiential learning, theoretical or research in nature." (Policy manual Part 12, section 3.A.3) As a NCTMB-Approved provider of continuing education, on January 1, 2003, AMTA began using the following formula: One (1) CEU (Continuing Education Unit) is awarded for ten (10) contact (clock) hours of organized approved continuing education experience. For example: 21 hours of instruction could be listed as 21 contact (clock) hours or 2.1 CEUs. 48 hours of instruction could be listed as 48 contact (clock) hours or 4.8 CEU's.
