

Myanmar's Current Situation: The Myanmar Military has been mercilessly killing innocent civilians, including young college students, professionals, and even children as young as five years old. To this day, over 600 people have been killed and almost 2,600 people, have been unlawfully detained. To fight back against the military, essential workers, medical staff, engineers, educators, and government employees from different sectors started the Civil Disobedience Movement (CDM) in the form of peaceful demonstrations and marches known as the Spring Revolution.

Our Goal: We are trying to help families in need. Families who have lost loved ones are having trouble surviving. 100% of the proceeds from this event will go to on-the-ground needs for Myanmar, such as:

- Security and protection for internally displaced persons (IDP) in Karen State
- Families of the fallen and of those detained indefinitely
- Families of those evicted from their homes due to their participation in the CDM movement
- Low-income families who can no longer earn a living due to the implementation of martial law
- Medicine and medical expenses of those injured in the violent crackdowns


