Develop a Love for the Word

The emphasis in working with

the children should be to help them develop a love for the Bible and an understanding that its truths can guide their lives daily.

Success in Junior Bible Quiz is not dependent on winning in competition. Success comes from internalizing God's Word and allowing it to guide the direction a child takes. Success comes when a child begins to develop a love for the Word of God.



Teach Important Lessons for Life

Children can learn valuable lessons through the competition of quizzing. Children can learn to win without boasting and lose without complaining. They can learn to treat opponents and officials with respect. They can learn discipline as they study for a match.

Competing allows opportunities

to help children grow in these areas:

- Learning the importance of rules
- Avoiding arguments
- Sharing in the responsibilities of the team
- Playing fair
- Following directions from the coach
- Respecting the other team's efforts
- Offering encouragement to teammates
- Accepting the judgment calls of the officials

Winning a competition must not become the primary goal for the coach, the parents, or the quizzers.

Expect children to work hard and do their best. Let them know this is the goal of quizzing. Quizzing is a fun way to show what quizzers have learned.

Individual competition is also a motivator for children. Use the tools available to help them compete against themselves as they strive to learn and understand more about God's Word and how it applies to them. Show the children how they are growing and learning more all the time, regardless of their placement in quizzing.
