Definition of Conflict

1 Conflict is...

a clash between two or more individuals or groups due to different opinions, values, or interests.

2 Not all conflicts are bad:

Some conflicts can lead to positive change, innovation, and growth.

(3) Causes of Conflict:

Competition for resources, differences in communication styles, power struggles.

Types of Conflict

Interpersonal Conflict

Occurs between individuals, often due to personal differences or misunderstandings.

Organizational Conflict

Arises within a company, department, or team due to conflicting goals or values.

Intergroup Conflict

Occurs between different groups within an organization, leading to rivalries or competition.

Impact of Conflict

Negative Impact:

- Reduced productivity
- Poor morale
- Increased stress

Positive Impact:

- Improved problem-solving skills
- Enhanced creativity
- Strengthened relationships

Strategies for Managing Conflict







Active Listening

Pay full attention and provide feedback to ensure understanding and empathy.

Negotiation

Seeking compromise and finding mutually beneficial solutions.

Win-Win Approach

Collaborate to find outcomes that address the needs of all parties involved.

Effective Communication in Conflict Resolution

Listen Actively

Focus on understanding the other person's perspective without interruption.

Non-Verbal Cues

Pay attention to body language and convey openness and attentiveness.

Speak Respectfully

Use "I" statements, maintain a calm tone, and avoid personal attacks.

Seek Clarification

Ask questions to ensure clear understanding and avoid assumptions.
