3. Interpret the Results

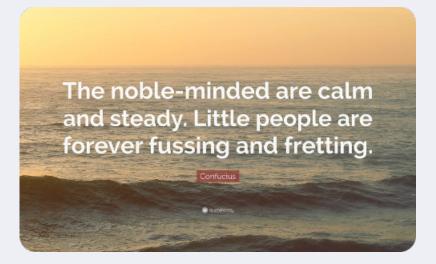
