Participants then spent the morning attending 3 separate short programs held at CIMM, CIYC, and MYSTIC WHALER, which included sailing images, stories, and hands-on activities provided by volunteers from CIWSA and CIYC members. Participants had the opportunity throughout the day to interact with women who sail and women who work in the marine or science world.

In the afternoon, everyone sailed for a few hours on the ocean near Channel Islands Harbor, some aboard MYSTIC WHALER with Captain Christine Healy and crew, and the rest on more modern boats skippered and crewed by local volunteers. After sailing, everyone returned to CIYC for a complimentary taco bar lunch, discussion about the day, raffle prizes including sailing lesson scholarships, and several local female Skippers and Captains, (Captain Christine Healy, Skipper Priscilla Becker, and Skipper Lauren Boyer) concluded the day by sharing their personal "sailing stories."
