Leaders of our local IOBG District 16 recognized CIWSA's longevity and community service and invited us to apply for IOBG membership, despite having only 4 (not 5) staff commodores since our founding. And they bent the rules for us!

Regular Member dues are \$120/year: Cruising, Associate, and Junior Member dues are \$60/year. Dues at all levels are reduced by 75% in July and August and by 50% after September 1!
