We will return to our usual locations and hours on September 19. For the most up-to-date information on hours and locations, please visit schools.nyc.gov/FWC.



REGISTRATION CHECKLIST

Be sure to bring the following when you register for school.

- Proof of your child's age (child's birth certificate, passport, or record of baptism),
- Your child's immunization records (if available),
- Your child's latest report card/transcript (if available), and
- Two (2) documents verifying proof of address—find examples of accepted documents at schools.nyc.gov/NewStudents.

***PLEASE NOTE:** Students in Temporary Housing, as defined by McKinney-Vento, are not required to submit documentation (including address, proof of date of birth, and immunization) to enroll. Schools must provisionally pre-register the student and then work with the students in temporary housing DOE contact to obtain documentation.
