In October, parents attended a meeting about our Title I Parent Advisory Council. They also attended workshops on student attendance and the high school application process. Other presentations and workshops are planned for upcoming months. We hope you will join us.

Many of our **after-school programs** have begun. Our Academic Intervention Services (AIS) program provides academic support in Reading, Math, Social Studies, Science and ENL for 6th, 7th and 8th grade students. Any parent who wants additional information about our AIS program should contact Mr. Galizia, assistant principal, or your child's guidance counselor. We also offer several **enrichment activities** in academic subjects as well as in the arts both before and after the regular school day. On Saturdays, we provide English language instruction for our English Language Learners from 8:00 to 11:00 AM. We will keep you informed about other extracurricular programs and services as they become available.

We work very hard to ensure that our school environment promotes equity and excellence and celebrates diversity. On October 22nd, some of our 7th grade students participated in a workshop conducted by the United Federation of Teachers, which focused on acceptance of differences, self-respect and bullying. All students have attended a special assembly program about the importance of speaking up and speaking out about community and social issues. We are participating again this year in the College Access for All initiative, which introduces 7th graders to a variety of aspects of college life.
