The Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame, formed in 1988, is a nonprofit organization with the following mission "To record and memorialize significant people, places and events in the history of trapshooting in the state of Idaho and to promote trapshooting and educate the public as to the values of the sport of and to preserve the history, records, artifacts and other memorabilia as well as to promote and provide inspiration to all trapshooters. Over the past 31 years 44 people have been inducted into the Idaho Hall of Fame, becoming part of the Idaho trapshooting legacy.

Idaho Trapshooting Hall of fame has explored building a facility for storage and display of historical trapshooting items several times. In 2018 a member of the Boise Gun Club offered \$10,000 toward the construction of an Idaho Shotgun Sports Museum at the Boise Gun Club if shooters will match the funds. This museum could become the physical home of the Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame.

The museum will include items and information dealing with hunting, the development of the shooting sports of trap, skeet and sporting clays, the history of shotguns and much more.

Hall of Fame Inductee

The Hall of Fame Board would like to thank David Poseley's daughter Renae Poseley James for her wonderful effort to describe the history behind this year's inductee into the Hall of Fame.

Please keep in mind that there is not enough space here to list all of the wins that David has brought home in the years he has been trap shooting.

It all began in 1958. At the age of 10 David began working at a trap club in Colorado as a puller. At that time, being a puller truly meant you were going to "pull" birds all day, and he worked for birds and not wages. There were no voice calls or buttons you could push, and he would pull a long bar back, and when the shooter yelled "pull," he would release it. Unfortunately, as it is today, kids couldn't afford this sport without the help of someone else. He was determined, even at his young age, not to be beholden to anyone, so he did the second-best thing—if he couldn't compete in the sport, he could work at a club and learn as much as he could about the sport from shooters. He has always had a love for guns, and trapshooting just called to him. That was the start of him becoming the great competitor and trapshooter he is today.

David has volunteered to teach children and adults how to shoot. If anyone he knows shows interest in this sport, he is the first to invite them to shoot, and offers to teach them. For a child shooting, David is the first to volunteer his time, his ammo, and a shotgun that is fit just for the child. The majority of people he has taught have become registered shooters, and still shoot trap to this day.

David has been deeply committed to going to as many competitions as he possibly can. Over the last 23 years he has traveled to Hawaii, Washington, Nevada, Utah, Arizona, Montana, and of course, all over the state of Idaho. During this time he had a very large number of wins, including wins at the Grand Pacific, the Idaho ATA state shoot, and the PITA state shoot.

Some of his major wins include:

2010 ATA Idaho State Handicap Champion (won four-way shoot off)) with 97 2014 PITA Idaho State Singles Champion with 199

2015 Grand Pacific Veteran's Singles Champion with 198

2015 Tie for Champion of Champions at the Grand Pacific

David earned selection to the Idaho PITA All-Star team seven straight years—from 2010 through 2016, and was captain or co-captain three of those years.

He shot 100 straight from 27 yards at the Twin Falls Gun Club, one of only five in the entire PITA that year.

David has also fired at over 55,000 PITA registered targets, and many more with the ATA.





REFUNDS - No entry fees, purses, or options will be refunded after the event has started. Also, no purse or options will be accepted after the first score sheet is posted. All refunds will be mailed with the payoffs. NO CASH REFUNDS.

CONDUCT - The Idaho PITA and the Pocatello Gun Club reserves the right to refuse entry or withdraw any contestant who in any way interferes with the safety, harmony, and enjoyment of this shoot.

PENALTY YARDAGE AND CLASSIFICATION - All shooters who have shot less than 500 registered handicap targets since they have started shooting will shoot at 22 yards for the State shoot only*. All shooters who have shot less than 500 registered 16 yard targets will shoot singles in A class for the State shoot only. All shooters who have shot less than 200 registered doubles targets will shoot in B class for the State shoot only. * Juniors. Sub-Juniors and Ladies may shoot at 20 yards.

ATA targets will count toward target requirements.

SPECIAL CATEGORIES:


- A Sub-junior is a person who has not attained their 15th birthday. For events where no Sub-junior trophy is offered, Sub-juniors shall be eligible to compete for the Junior trophy.
- A Junior is a person who has attained their 15th birthday but has not attained their 18th birthday.
- A Veteran is a person who has attained their 65th birthday but has not attained their 70th birthday.
- A Senior Veteran is a person who has attained their 70th birthday but has not attained their 75th birthday. For events where no Senior Veteran trophy is offered, Senior Veterans shall be eligible to compete for the Veteran trophy.
- An Elder is a person who has attained their 75th birthday. For events where no Elder trophy is offered, Elders shall be eligible to compete for the oldest category trophy available.
- A Rookie is any shooter who has shot less than one calendar year from the time they shot their first registered targets.

<u>Failure to Fire rule.</u> - You are allowed two failures to fire per sub-event in the 16 yard, handicap, and doubles events. It is not counted as a failure to fire if a "no target" is thrown. Check your rule book for details.

Handicap Rule. All shooters will shoot their longest handicap yardage, ATA or PITA.

BROKEN TARGET RULE - When a broken target is thrown, regardless of whether the shooter shoots at the target or not, it is declared "NO TARGET".

The State Board of Directors and the Pocatello Gun Club reserve the right to change or modify any part of the program, if necessary.

Virgil was born at home in Missouri to Rubie and Elias Perry on September 11, 1935. In 1936, the Perry family moved to Meridian, Idaho and bought a farm. The family farm is where he grew up, learned about a good day's work and cultivated his mechanical know-how and problem-solving skills.

His knowledge, aptitude and ability to work well with his hands led him to a successful welding career. He worked on many construction and pipeline projects in the Treasure Valley and across the western U.S. including the Hanford FFTF and replacing the oil pipelines on the Pearl Harbor base.

His many interests and activities kept him busy and included driving and building race cars, boat building and enjoying time on the lake with family and friends, riding motorcycles, gardening and competition trapshooting.

Trapshooting was his passion up to just a few years prior to his death. He won several trapshooting titles through the years and was inducted into the Idaho State Trapshooting Hall of Fame an honor he was extremely proud of.

Virgil had amazing resilience and many accomplishments throughout his life, but eventually succumbed to cancer on November 13, 2019.

He married Marilyn Carr in 1954 and together they had five girls. They later divorced and he married Betty Schmidt in 1977.

Virgil is survived by his wife, Betty; five daughters, Deb, Bev (Mike), Barb (Jake), Kathy (Barry), Judy (Orv); stepchildren Dee (George), and Brian (Denise); grandchildren and great grandchildren, his sisters Joan, Darlene, and Diann. His parents, siblings David, Lila and Imogene preceded him in death.




