

Update on implementation of the ISTA Constitutional Amendment adopted May 26, 2019.

An ISTA Constitutional Change adopted in 2019 resulted in a phased in process to reach the status of electing one director for each zone each year. The objective in this change was to enhance the Board of Director’s capability of meeting the state objective of the organization which is to: “promote the interest of Trapshooting and to make all regulations pertaining thereto”. This responsibility requires that the Board of Directors act in such a manner as to promote and support the sport throughout the State of Idaho. It is the full membership that elects all members of the Board, not just the membership of the zone. The adopted change to the constitution ensures that prospective members of the Board are representative of the entire ISTA membership. The change assures greater statewide continuity of the state wide Board of Directors by assuring that at any time there are Directors from each zone who have experience in enacting the role of the Board.

Article IV Section 2: There shall be a Board of nine (9) Directors, the President and Vice President to be members of said Board. The State shall be divided into three (3) zones as follows:
 Northern zone will provide three (3) Directors, Southeastern zone will provide three (3) Directors and the Southwest zone will provide three (3) Directors. The Directors shall be elected for a three (3) year term, during the State Shoot. One Director for each zone will be elected each year. The State Delegate is a non-voting member of the Board.

REGISTRATION

Registration and Squadding will be available 1 to 6 pm Thursday May 27, 2021 and beginning 7:30 A.M. each morning of the shoot.

1. Take your ATA card to the handicap table. Have your average card ready, with all averages up to date, including a doubles average. (Note: 3S Shooting Software may be used to determine ATA shooting history and class eligibility). **If you have a PITA card, it is your responsibility to present it at the handicap table and if desired, to notify the cashier to Cross-Register your targets.)**
2. Specialty Classes: It is your responsibility to notify the handicap committee of your special classification
LD1, LD2, SUB VT, VET, SR VET, SUB JR, JR, JR GOLD
3. Select events, purses and options prior to arriving at the cashiering windows.
4. Go to Squadding Window for squad assignments
5. Take all forms to the cashiering window. Make all checks payable to the Idaho State Trapshooting Association (ISTA).

Any shooter who wishes to squad another shooter must have the second shooter's permission, and the necessary forms (average card, plastic card, ATA number etc.) to facilitate the handicapping process.

Hi everyone. Covid slowed down or changed many of our shooting activities in 2020 & it also affected the progress of fundraising & planning for construction for the ISSM project. We were able to accomplish several things during the slowdown however.

We became incorporated in the state of Idaho and we received Sec 501 (c) (3) status from the IRS.

SHOOT RULES AND INFORMATION

ADVANCE SQUADDING

This is encouraged, and can be done at www.Presquad.com. You must still go through the Handicap Table upon arrival at the club.

SCORERS & SCORING

Your score will be called at the end of each 5 shots, 10 for Doubles. It is the duty of the contestant to have any error corrected before he/she has fired the first shot at the succeeding position or in the case of his last post before he/she leaves the trap. No corrections for mismarked targets can be made after the squad has departed the trap.

TARGET SETTING

Target setting will be under the direction of the ISTA and the Pocatello Trap Club. No targets will be changed without permission from an ISTA or Pocatello Trap Club Director.

REFUNDS

No entry fees, purses or options will be refunded after the event has started. All refunds will be mailed to the shooters with the payoffs.

LATE SHOOTERS

Watch your squad number. No Shooter will be called on the speaker. Shooters missing their squad will be re-squadded only if they pay a \$10.00 re-squadding fee. There will be NO waiting period.

ATA POINTS

Maximum ATA points for resident and non-resident shooters will be available at this shoot. Please read the current rules regarding awarding of points.

MONEY DIVISION

All purses and added money divided High Gun System unless otherwise noted. No Monies can be played after the first squad takes the line.

STATE TEAM RACE

Must consist of one AA, one A, one B, one C, and one D shooter. A lower class shooter can move up classes. Team must enter before first half of singles race starts. One Team per Idaho Club.

SHOOTOFFS

All preliminary event ties will be carried over to the next like event, unless a shoot off is needed because of a change in yardage (i.e. a tie results in earned yardage) There will be a shoot off held for Championship Events. A shoot off committee of the ISTA Directors and State Delegate will conduct and oversee all shoot offs. Please see them for any information concerning shoot offs.

NOTE: REASONABLE EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO NOTIFY YOU OF A SHOOT OFF, HOWEVER YOU MUST BE PRESENT WHEN CALLED OR FORFEIT.

NOTE: CHANGES FOR HOA AND HAA SCORES

High Over All and High All Around scores will be computed by the cashier and posted following Event #10. Shooters will be responsible for checking these sheets for errors and notify the score board personnel. The 16 yard classification of a shooter in Event #1 will be used to determine HOA classification.

PAYOFF

All payoffs will be posted as soon as possible following the event. All shooters will receive a payoff sheet following the shoot. Payoffs will be made by check and mailed to shooters.

Classification

PENALTY YARDAGE AND CLASSIFICATION

The handicap committee may assign a MINIMUM of 22 yards and Class B Singles and Class B Doubles to any shooter who does not have an established shooting history; however, any trapshooting history may be used to establish classification and yardage. In all cases, known ability will have a strong bearing on classification. A shooter belonging to another shooting association will be required to shoot from his or her longest yardage. Any questions may be referred to the Handicap Committee for evaluation.

TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded at the conclusion of shooting each day; it is the shooters responsibility to make arrangements for someone to pick-up or arrange to have the trophies to be mailed if the shooter has to leave before the trophies are finalized. If trophies are mailed, shooter may be responsible for postage.


100 and 200 STRAIGHTS

NOTICE OF TAXATION



The Internal Revenue Service (IRS)

requires that anyone making \$600 or more at a shoot report those earnings to the IRS via the shoot host. In order for the shoot host to do this required reporting, we MUST have the Social Security Number (SSN) or Tax ID of the shooters that win \$600 or more. This is accomplished by completing an IRS Form W9. If you think you may have \$600 or more in winnings, please legibly complete a W9 form and return it to Joe Eichert or the Cashier's desk.

Chester Carter

Chester Carter began shooting trap in Ohio at age 16. In 1968 he joined the Air Force, & while stationed at Hill AFB, Utah he began shooting again as a member of the USAF trap team. In 1982 Chester was in Pruem, Germany where he ran the Bitberg AFB Gun Club. He enjoyed shooting International trap in Germany, Belgium & Luxenberg. In 1988 Chester retired from the Air Force & moved to Boise, Idaho where he has been a member of the Boise Gun Club ever since.

After leaving the Air Force he began working for the Federal Aviation Administration & spent 24 years working on heavy ground radar systems. That led to him having close to 45 years of experience working on radar systems.

Chester is a life member of the ATA & the NRA. His many trapshooting accomplishments include being named member of the ATA All American Team in 2017 and making the PITA All Star Team five times to date. His lengthy and very impressive list of wins began in 1991 with a Co-Champion Handicap win at Walla Walla, Washington. Carter continued taking trophies at state, zone and PITA Grand events with well over 70 titles. These include many championship titles in PITA and ATA state shoots including Montana, Oregon, Idaho, and Nevada State Shoots. He likes to travel to the Autumn Grand at Tucson, where he is quite successful, collecting eight titles over the years.

Chester has vastly contributed to the sport of trapshooting. He served on the Boise Gun Club board for about nine years, served on the PITA state board for a couple more years, and was the alternate ATA Delegate for an additional year. Never afraid of work, Chester has repaired traps, installed voice release systems and card readers, mowed weeds and removed snow. He was a volunteer at the 1998 Grand American and also volunteered and various clubs both in and out of Idaho. He helped run many different state shoots by maintaining and repairing trap machines, speakers and setting targets.

When we asked Chester to send us his shooting history, including specific dates, he replied "you ask for dates and I can't remember what I had for breakfast!" demonstrating his wonderful sense of humor.

Chester is a great example of trapshooter who promotes the sport and contributes to the success of any event where he is working. He demonstrates sportsmanship and is generous with his time, skills and many donations to trapshooting. We congratulate him on his induction to the Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame.

Joe Eichert

Joe Eichert began his shooting career in 1970 & has been shooting registered targets ever since. He is a life member of Orofino Gun Club & the ATA, & an annual member of the PITA. Currently his ATA target total is 119, 175.

Camas Prairie Trapshooting Association (CPTA)

Joe has been a director on the CPTA Coard since 1970. He has served as an officer and has never missed a SPTA shoot. He was VP in 1974, 1981, 1987 & 2009; he served as President in 1997. He has served on the CPTA Handicap, Grievance, Trap-setting, Shoot-Off and Trophies Committees.

Idaho State Trapshooting Association (ISTA)

Joe served on the ISTA in multiple roles. During his tenure on the board the association thrived, and his presence and participation contributed to it's success. His recent efforts have helped the ISTA become financially sound and contributed to the quality of the annual Idaho State Shoot. He was on the ISTA Board of Directors 1975-1987 and has again been serving on the Board as Secretary-Treasurer since 2017. He was VP for three years, and was Secretary-Treasurer for seven years before returning to that role four years ago.

Orofino-Pierce Gun Club:

Orofino-Pierce Gun Club was originally located on leased Nez Perce Tribal Grounds. In early 1990's the club was notified the lease would not be renewed. An al-out search was launched to locate a new site to establish a club. Joe found a site on an old home-stead owned by Potlatch Corporation. He was instrumental in securing the lease and acquiring the necessary easement. During the development and building phases of the new club they remained active in the Camas Prairie competition by having members shoot at Nezperce Gun Club, and hosting their annual shoots at the Lewiston Gun Club. The fist registered shoot at the new club was held in March 1999. Joe's hard work and commitment were major factors that kept the club active and intact during this time, remaining in good standing with the ATA and the ISTA. In 2014 the club was able to purchase 34 acres and since Joe has helped obtain three grants from the Friends of the NRA, enabling the gun club to upgrade traps and start an active competitive Junior Trapshooting Program.

The Shooter & Friend

Joe has shot from Class D to AA and back down again. He was punched to the 27 yard line four times. His list of trophies is considerable, highlighted by Camas All Star Teams in 1986 & 1989. Joe made the state team in 1975. He has taken High Overall and High All Around wins in Idaho, Montana and Washington just to mention a few.

Joe's lifetime contribution to the sport of trapshooting sets a high bar of achievement and presents an inspiration to everyone associated with the sport.. He is hard working, loyal and perseverant (maybe stubborn). He has been a great friend to many of us on and off the line for many years and we wholeheartedly congratulate him as he is induct-ed into the Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame.

Liz Harris

Liz Harris will be joining her Idaho State Hall of Fame husband Kent to form the third husband and wife team in the state Hall of Fame. Virgil & Viva Baldwin; Dan & Darlene McKenzie are the other two. Liz will also be inducted into the PITA Hall of Fame at ceremonies at the PITA Grand in July. A very well deserved honor for a person that has put so much effort & volunteered so much of her time & energy to make the shooting experience so much better for all of us.

Liz began shooting at the Boise & Caldwell Gun Clubs in 1982., shooting her first registered target in 1984. While these would become her two “home” clubs over the years, she would also had memberships in several others, including Ontario, Twin Falls, and Burley. Over Liz’s shooting career of 36 years, she roamed the Northwest, shooting at clubs in Idaho, Oregon, Nevada, Washington, British Columbia, & Utah. At many of these clubs Liz was quick to lend a hand where she found a need, & helped several clubs with their first registered shoots. In her shooting career, Liz has amassed an impressive list of wins & awards within both the PITA & ISTA.

Pacific International Trap Association (PITA)

Liz has taken wins at over thirty PITA shoots. She reigned Champion in various Lady Classes, Doubles, Handicap, & Singles events. She has garnered trophies at Idaho PITA State, Oregon State, Nevada State, & Grand Pacific shoots.

Liz was a 29 time member of the Idaho PITA All-Star Team, six times as Ladies Team Captain or Co-Captain. She was the first woman shooter from Idaho to register 100,000 PITA targets, and earned placement on the PITA High Over All teams list in C Class in 2015 and B Class in 2019. Over the past 30 plus years has served as an official for the Idaho PITA & an un-official representative at the PITA executive level.

Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA)

Liz also earned numerous ATA trophies at local and State shoots, including wins in Lady Handicap, Singles, Lady Preliminary Handicap, Husband and Wife, and Lady High Combined.

Liz and Kent Harris married in 1986. Along the way, Liz raised two daughters & had a 31 year teaching career. She shot when she could, but not as often as she wanted. In 2007 she was punched to the 25 yard line, & looked to be on her way to the 27; but, she ran into health problems that affected her shooting, & eventually caused her retirement from teaching. Liz has spent time in the past few years being a caregiver to several family members. She hopes to continue shooting in the future, adding more clubs (& wins) to her list, while meeting new people & continuing to enjoy the sport of trapshooting.

We congratulate Liz Harris on her very deserved induction into the Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame.

He was a life member of the Twin Falls Gun Club, the NRA and annual member of other clubs in the state. Gail has been instrumental in helping with team shoots, fundraising turkey shoots with local law enforcement, and teaching kids, women and anyone else in need of help shooting.


Gail served as a director in the ISTA and the PITA, was a Twin Falls board member for many years, serving as President multiple times. During his involvement, many projects and general improvements were completed. Gail along with his Wife Phyllis, donated the kitchen equipment and labor when the kitchen was remodeled at the club.

Gail shot many 100 straights in singles and also recorded 100 straights in handicap and doubles. He even shot on a 499 singles squad. Guess who had the 99?!

His gun collection of rifles, pistols and numerous shotguns include Perazzis, which were his favorite i.e. TM1, MX8 and RS High Tech. Gail had a room full of reloading supplies for his three reloaders, and cases of Remington shells, his favorite. He kept Sportsman's Warehouse supplied with empty hulls!

At the age of 70 he had a 94 ATA singles average and at the age of 79 and 80 he was opening the gun club on Thursdays for practice. He also had time to play cribbage and gin rummy. Gail did not know a stranger and loved talking with everyone. He truly enjoyed shooting at the state shoots. The Pocatello Gun Shoot and the PITA Grand were among his favorites. In 2019, the year before he regrettably passed away, he still was a fine competitor taking PITA Grand Elder Singles Champion with 100, he also winning the PITA State Elder Doubles Championship, With a voice and laugh that were so "Big" you could always find him in a crowded club house was the way in one of his granddaughters described him so very accurately. That seems like a fitting memory to a great gentleman of the sport.

There is a draw score in each of the first 9 events including the 1st and 2nd 100 of the singles.

All participants' scores, excluding the high score, are entered into a drawing at no cost to the shooter.

If there is only one shooter with the drawn score, that person wins \$100. If there are more than one the shooters with the drawn score can participate in a Miss And Out Shoot Off at the end of the shoot day. The winner of the shoot off wins \$100. Wins are limited to one during the 4 day event. (Ties may split if they choose, but all persons with that score are then ineligible for future draws).

All Sub Junior and Junior Shooter scores are entered into another drawing at no cost to the shooter. If there is only one shooter with the drawn score, that person wins \$50. If there are more than one, the shooters with the drawn score can participate in a Miss and Out Shoot Off at the end of the shoot day. The winner of the shoot off wins \$50. Sub juniors and Juniors are automatically entered into any event in which they participate. There is no limit to number of events they may win for the \$50 SJ-J Draw Score. .

This Draw Score is for the first 9 events, and is NOT available for the Championship Handicap, because people are departing. We hope everyone travels safe!



ATA DAILY FEES

The ATA in its program of building strong state associations, aids them financially; from the \$20 annual membership, \$2 is returned to the state organization. From the \$500 life membership, \$150 is returned to the state organization over a ten (10) year period & part is retained in a special ATA emergency fund. From the \$3 daily fee, twenty percent (20%) is returned to the state organization.

These refunds are made to the State Association ten days prior to the State Tournament, provided such tournament is held and provided the State turns into the ATA at least \$200 from annual membership dues and registration fees. From this refund, there will be deducted an amount equal to any fines due because of late shoot reports. On or before January 1 of each year the ATA shall inform the secretary of each State of the approximate amount of refund to be paid to that state.




