OUTREACH PROGRAMS

LINCOLN DENTAL STUDENTS TREAT REFUGEES IN KUALA LUMPUR

On August 3, 2022, 4th year dental students from Lincoln University College, Malaysia were having a Dental Community Project in Rohingya Intellectual Skills and Excellence supervised by Dr. Misliah Binti Ahmad.

The goal of this project, in which 23 students took part, was to improve the oral health of refugees.



According to the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) in Malaysia, as of the end of March 2021, 178,920 refugees and asylum-seekers were registered with UNHCR in Malaysia. Most of them are from Myanmar, and of these, 102,560 are Rohingyas and 45,720 are children below the age of 18. Most of the refugees are concentrated around the capital, Kuala Lumpur, and Selangor. Since the 1990s, they have been forced to leave their country to escape discrimination, persecution, and war. Luckily, Islamic Relief Malaysia has taken a big step by opening the Rohingya Intellectual Skills & Excellence Alternative Learning Center for Rohingya refugees in Taman Kajang Utama in 2017.

MENTAL HEALTH SURVEY CONDUCTED BY MEDICAL FACULTY

Lincoln University College's Medical Faculty pre-clinical students have arranged a field trip to the Perdana Botanical Garden on 13th June 2023 and conducted a comprehensive mental health survey, randomly selecting 100 individuals from Taman Butani Perdana. They engaged with the community, fostering open conversations about stress, anxiety, depression, and emotional well-being. The field trip also included health screenings, such as blood pressure measurement, BMI, glucose test and brief consultations to address any immediate health concerns, to assess physical well-being alongside mental health. Additionally, the students organized exciting activities like treasure hunts and games to promote teamwork, problem-solving skills, and provide a break from academic routine.

This time, we had the opportunity to hold a volunteer program at one of the spastic schools located at Petaling Jaya known as the Spastic Children's Association of Selangor & Federal Territory. It is an honor for our faculty to collaborate with Jaafar Institute this year to make the program a success.











Throughout the program, the students were very excited and enjoyed serving the students from the spastic school. They are divided into several small groups and each of them has to help the spastic students to do activities in the class. All the students agreed that carrying out activities with children with special needs was quite challenging considering that this was the first time they volunteered at the school.

However, they feel that a program like this to some extent gives them the awareness that every human being should be given the best and deserved treatment even though they are special. In addition to that, this activity to some extent produces students who are active and able to communicate with the community.


INVITED LECTURE BY STIKES BANI SALEH, INDONESIA






