
- I. Ensuring access to quality teachers

- III. Establishment of safe and supportive quality learning environments




## The Effective Publication Strategies at the International Reputable Scientific Journals

## International Conference on Recent Trends in Business and Entrepreneurial Ventures (ICRTBEV 2023)


