- Scholastic Ability (B-C grade average)
- Character
- Activities & Community Service
- Financial Need

The intent is to award scholarships to three qualified applicants. Eligible applicants are students who attend Haverhill High School, Whittier Regional Vocational Technical High School, Pentucket Regional High School, or a Haverhill resident who attends another school or is home schooled.

Consideration shall be given only to accredited post-secondary schools approved by the Scholarship Committee and accredited by the State Board of Education of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts or by corresponding agencies of other states.

Two of the three Pentucket Kiwanis scholarships are named for members who were actively involved in improving local education, the **David Lowes Scholarship** and the **Ann Mootrey Nelson Scholarship**.

David Lowes was a club member, a Haverhill resident, educator, and businessman. He was involved in numerous community events that improved life in our city. Ann Mootrey Nelson was a club member and a Haverhill resident whose work with a charitable foundation provided financial assistance that improved educational resources at many schools in the Haverhill area,
