Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

2 Corinthians 1:8–9 8 For we would not, brethren, have you ignorant of our trouble which came to us in Asia, that ***we were pressed out of measure***, above strength, insomuch that we despaired even of life: **9** But we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves, but in God which raiseth the dead: Sometimes it seems we need to be reminded that God is in control and that you can always trust Him.
