Camp stations incorporate learning through hands-on, active participation with the youth. They will journey through life of youth from years past. All the activities are centered around learning from the past and growing for the future.

Stations will include:

**Home Life** - Learning the responsibilities of children from cooking to chores, and other general home care and life.

**School Life** - School life will include mini lessons in a one-room, multi age classroom. Tasks, chores, games and other school day activities.

**Animal Care** - They will learn the importance animals were to life, grooming and feeding, and animal chores.
