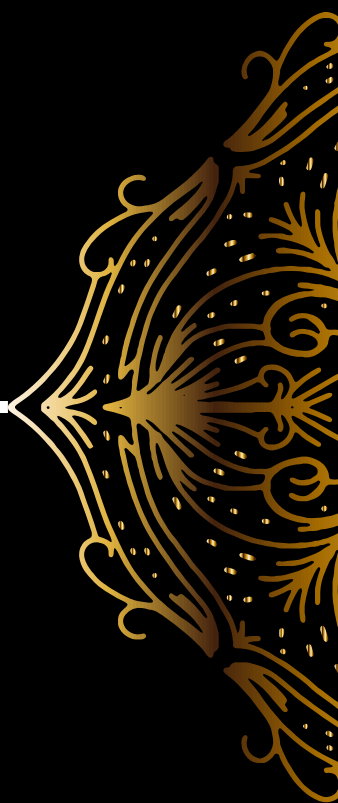

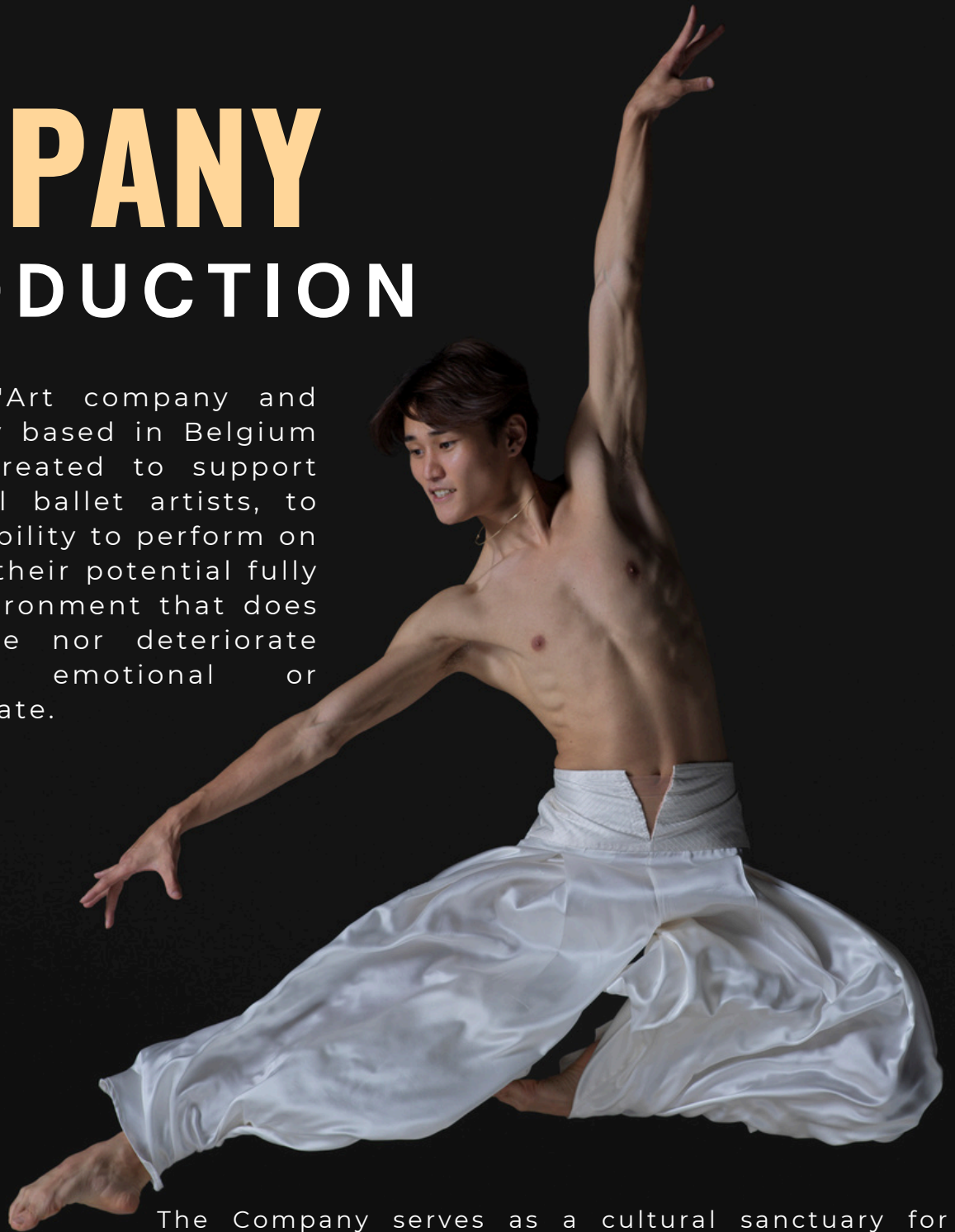

Lara Paraschiv is a professional ballerina, pedagogue, and choreographer that has graduated from the Bolshoi Ballet Academy in Moscow.

Her career commenced in Russia and further developed in Ukraine, NYC, Romania, and England.

She has been performing worldwide on renowned stages in England, USA, Australia, Singapore, China, France, Italy, Switzerland and Netherlands.

Her repertoire developed progressively from dancing corps de ballet to principle roles.

Her experience was well rounded in learning various styles and versions of choreography including; Danish, English, Russian, Ukranian, French, and Romanian. She was humbly grateful to be invited as a guest artist at the Royal Opera House in London to take classes and rehearse.

During this time she also became certified by the Royal Ballet School Teachers Program. Her aim now is to bring her expertise to develop technically adequate future artists, and lastly create opportunities for dancers worldwide to be able to pursue their passion and love of ballet as Lara did.

TRAINING AND PERFORMANCE

Our training program is led by professional ballet artists who have danced on stages world wide. The program consists of Royal Ballet School, Vaganova and Cecchetti methodology. The program aims to lead dancers to reach their true potential as artists without having to stress or worry about the technique.

Our dancers will become confident and stable in their ballet technique so that when they perform on stage, all that is left is to dance from the soul.



In addition to daily intensive training, we offer our dancers a full immersive experience in performing as professional dancers.

They will not only train and rehearse alongside professionals but also perform on stage as one! Each season will consist of a minimum of 25 performances revolving around classical repertoire that is demanded by all professional ballet companies today.

Being a dancer with Ballet Del'Art will give you opportunities in performances all around the world in classical works such as Swan Lake, Nutcracker, Giselle, Don Quixote and more.

The dancers will also get upfront experience with professional choreographers and répétiteurs from renowned companies and theatres.

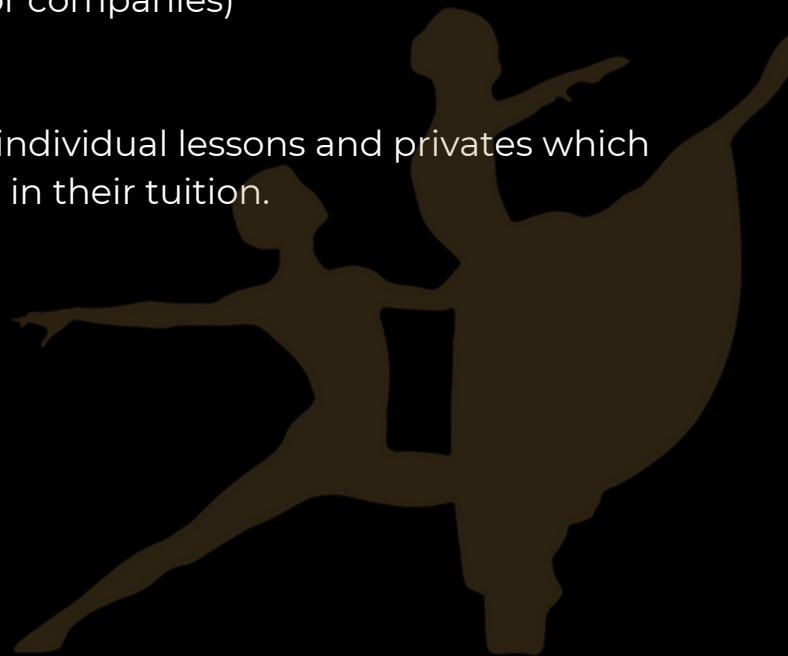
12:00-12:30 Stretch and strengthening

Saturdays and Sundays are dedicated to individual lessons and privates which PTP get access to for free as it is included in their tuition.





COMPANY SEASON

Each season will have different opportunities for performances based on the demand and request.

For this season we have planned over 25 performances. These performances include a brand new production of Swan Lake, Nutcracker and a Grand Ballet Gala that will be performed in Europe and England.

In the future we plan to expand our performances to USA, Canada, Japan, Korea, Singapore, and Australia.

During performance season, Ballet Del'Art will hold accountability for the travel and accommodation of all dancers.

For each performance dancers will receive a salary for their work and dedication given.



WHAT WE EXPECT FROM YOU



THE RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE DANCER

1. Punctuality is just as important as attendance, please be on time and prepared for class. Students should not miss more than five (5) of any one class per dance season: after which, the dancer may be dismissed from the program. Dance requires consistent ongoing training, and dancers who excessively miss classes will not be able to perform at the same level as those who have been in attendance regularly. Dancers must be present in ALL their classes and rehearsals the week prior to every performance and tour
2. Communicating negatively about anyone in or outside our studio will not be tolerated. Dancers are expected to show courtesy and respect to all instructors and other students. Any Student or teacher who exhibits repeated negative or disrespectful behavior will have to mediate actions, or their contract will be terminated. Everyone is expected to be always respectful, supportive, encouraging, and constructive in spirit, attitude, and behavior. Our company has 0 tolerance to discrimination and abuse.
3. In order for Trainees and PTP to be a part of performances with professional dancers, they are expected to be technically competent, physically, mentally and emotionally mature.

In order to achieve this, dancers must be eating well, resting, hydrating and putting their intentions and focus on the progression and development of themselves in and outside the studio. They will have to display constructive communication and conflict resolutions skills
4. Dancers are expected and required to report to class/rehearsals/performances on time and in appropriate mental and physical condition. It is our intent and obligation to provide a drug-free, healthful and safe environment. Our policy is to employ an environment free from alcohol abuse or the use of illégál drugs. This company takes drug and alcohol abuse as a serious matter and will not tolerate it. The company absolutely prohibits the use of alcohol or non-prescribed drugs before and during training hours, rehearsals performances and while on company premises.
