## **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

Kelsey Hofe teaches a 6-week intensive class for aspiring and seasoned theatre performers who want to learn how to find and perform monologues. Students will learn to fine-tune text and analyze characters through instructive videos, one-on-one Zoom lessons and a final performance.

### **As a result of this course you will be able to:**

- Find contemporary monologues that work for your “type” (young, strong, sassy, funny, dramatic, scientific, artsy, poetic, sporty, etc.)
- Find monologues that are rich with action (story-telling monologues can sometimes be less interesting)
- Research monologues source material. (play, film, poem, etc.) What happened before this moment? What happens after?
- Learn to break down a monologue sentence by sentence.
- Apply actions and direction to the monologue.
- Memorize a monologue
- Receive notes on rehearsals of monologue and apply them.
- Give a final performance via Zoom. You may invite friends, family, and other classmates to view the performance.

- Thursday: Action work (how to apply verbs to lines)

Week 3:

Week 4:

- Tuesday: Act the monologue. Receive notes.
- Thursday: Act the monologue. Apply Tuesdays notes.

Week 5:

- Tuesday: Act the memorized monologue. Receive notes.
- Thursday: Final prep for performance.

Week 6:

- Tuesday: Performances!
- Thursday: Performances if not all of them were completed.
