Submission Requirements

Submissions for this exhibition must be sent to the Exhibition Committee at services@beckleyartcenter.com. Artists may submit up to six (6) photographs in any media.

To submit, digital images of each entry should be attached and sent by email on or before the submission deadline. If you need advice on photographing artwork, please let us know.

Images must be .JPEG format in at least 300 dpi. Image files must be titled "Lastname_Title" for each piece.

All artist's work(s) will be selected for the exhibition if said work meets the theme.

Inclusion of artwork is at the sole discretion of the BAC Exhibition Committee.
