

## Ground Rules

- 1) Drag after 5 in Barrels
- 2) Move barrels every 10
- 3) Barrels will be after bulls in night slacks
- 4) Slack order may vary from performance order
- 5) Escaped animal in performance will be replaced with extra.
- 6) One and a short even if less than 15 entries
- 7) A coin flip will break any tie in all events
- 8) Timed events exit back of arena (center out gate)

Thank you and your team members for the top-notch conduct at the Vernon College Rodeo the past few years. There have been very few disruptive incidents and the grounds have been left in appropriate condition. A couple of items of information to assist you and your team members.

1. The Event Center parking area has undergone some renovation to allow more parking for parents, friends, etc. to attend the rodeo. No trailer parking will be allowed in the parking lot area west of the Event Center. No trailer parking means no trailer parking. This will be enforced to provide better access for spectators to attend the rodeo.
2. Stalls are available. Event Center policy is that no horses are to be tied to trailers overnight. Stalls are \$20 per stall per night (CASH\$\$. Stalls may be reserved and paid for in the Event Center office on the south end of the arena by the concession stand. Stalls are first come first serve basis.
3. Electric hook-ups are available for trailers for \$20 per hook-up per night (CASH\$). Electric hook-ups may be paid for in the Event Center office.
4. In an effort to ensure the safety and security of contestants that stay in trailers at the arena and their livestock as well as ensuring that the parking lots and grounds are left in better condition, officers from the Vernon College police department will be on duty each night before the performances throughout the night until early morning. They will be patrolling the facility, parking lots, and grounds. Vernon College officers are fully licensed police officers and will be issuing Minor in Possession, Public Intoxication, Disorderly Conduct, investigating noise level complaints, and will have backup from the local PD if any arrests are necessary.

Vernon city ordinances require all pets to be on a leash in public places.
