Slacks will begin Thursday at 5:00 pm, Slack after Thursday and Friday and Friday and Saturday morning at 8:00 am, order of events may very

Performances will start at 7:00 pm Thursday, Friday and Saturday

In the TD, BK, SW, and TR events the contestants competing and the next contestants will be allowed in the arena but must stay close to the fence and out of spectator view.

GT and BA contestants will enter arena from the rough stock out gate

All timed event contestants will leave the arena from the rough stock end

No one will be allowed to sit on an arena fence

The platform just east of the heading box will be for coaches only to sit on (no standing on the platform)

There will be parking attendants at the cattle guard on the highway that will take you and park in an orderly fashion. Our parking is limited and there will be an overflow parking at the COEA arena in town, located 2 blocks north of Hwy 287 on AYERS St. If you are not competing in that days slack or performance you may be asked to go to the overflow parking.

Be sure to have a current Coggins on all horses entering our facility
