## **Howard College Rodeo Ground Rules**

Howard College will be hosting the Howard College Rodeo April 11-13, 2024.

The Rodeo will be held at the Big Spring Cowboy Reunion & Rodeo Bowl.

Slack order may vary from perf order, starting at 9 am

Performances will start at 7:00 pm Thursday, Friday and Saturday

### **General Ground Rules**

- 1. Only identified workers, coaches, event directors and rodeo officials will be allowed in the arena.
- 2. If you are on the dirt, or on the fences in the arena you must be in dress code.
- 3. Only contestants with a qualified ride/run will compete in the short round regardless of the number of entries.
- 4. The arena will be closed—No Riding in the arena any time.
- 5. Park where instructed or where the signage tells you to. If not parked where you are supposed to you will be towed.
- 6. No tying horses to Chain link fences, or Chain link fences to make horse pens.
- 7. Current Coggins and health papers are required to enter the grounds.
- 8. Steer roping will count towards Men's All-Around prize
- 9. In the tiedown roping there will be half enough calves and they will have one run put on them.
- 10. All Ties will be broke in the arena.

#### **Timed Events**

- 1. Barrel Races and Goat Tiers will enter the arena with an open gate on the run.
- 2. Goat tying contestants may not leave through the center of the arena.
- 3. An escaped animal in the performance will be replaced by the extra.
- 4. Goat score will be 190ft.

#### Rough Stock

- 1. Only contestants and Coaches are permitted behind the chutes.
- 2. Riders must exit the arena after their ride.
- 3. All Rough Stock events will be one and a short regardless of the number entered.

# Drags

We will drag before and after 5 barrel racers in performances.

We will drag after 5 barrel racers in slack. We will drag before every event in slack. (drag every 7 in goats, drag halfway through breakaway)
