STEP 1 - READ

(1) Choose a book or passage of the Bible to read. (2) Before reading the passage, pray Psalm 119:18-"Lord open my eyes that I may see wondrous things in your law." Read the passage slowly and read it again. Take note of words describing God, note any keywords or phrases that you see in repetition.
