IMMUTABILITY

OMNIPOTENCE IMMUTABILE : unchangeable,

changeless, unchanging, constant, stable, unvarying, unwavering,

Mutable: changeable: capable of change or of

being changed in form, quality, or nature ; capable of or liable to mutation ; fickle, inconsistent, uncertain, unpredictable, unsettled, unstable,

The IMMUTABILITY OF

GOD IS UNCHANGEABLE -

Malachi 3:6 ; JAMES 1:17; Isaiah 46:8-11; REVELATION 1:8

He is ALL BEING, never becoming - all that He is and all that He has can never change.

- Nothing can be added to Him or taken from Him.
- Any kind of change would imply that God was something more or something less than He was, is, or will be.
- He does not change, He does not lie, He is what He is
- His nature cannot be altered for better or worse
- He learns nothing, He needs nothing, He does not grow or improve.
- His knowledge can never increase or decrease
- His purpose always comes to pass

- Romans 11:33-36 -God possesses all knowledge
- Matthew 12:25 & Isaiah 66:18 God knows man's thoughts
- Proverbs 15:3 God sees & knows all things, all the time
- **Isaiah 40:28** God's knowledge, wisdom & understanding at work.
- Job 37 (v.16) -God's knowledge, wisdom & handiwork.
- Psalm 139: 2-18 God's perfect knowledge
- Acts 15:18 "Known to God from eternity are all His works"

- Daniel 4:35 God's will is His power
- Exodus 4:10-12 -God speaks to us and through us.
