As May begins and we prepare to celebrate mothers across Haiti, the U.S., and Canada through our Mother's Day campaign, we're also taking a moment to reflect on April. From welcoming our supporters through our virtual clinic tour to celebrating two birthdays within our Family Support Program, here's a glimpse of what kept us busy.

From one mother to another, this Mother's Day—and in honor of celebrations across North America and in Haiti—we're dedicating the month of May to the journey every mother deserves. At Kay Akouchman, a full continuum of care—from the first prenatal visit through postpartum follow-up—costs about \$1,100 USD (1,494.8 CAD). This month, we're working to raise funds to support 10 mothers with safe, compassionate care.

**Birth & Patient Registration Update:**

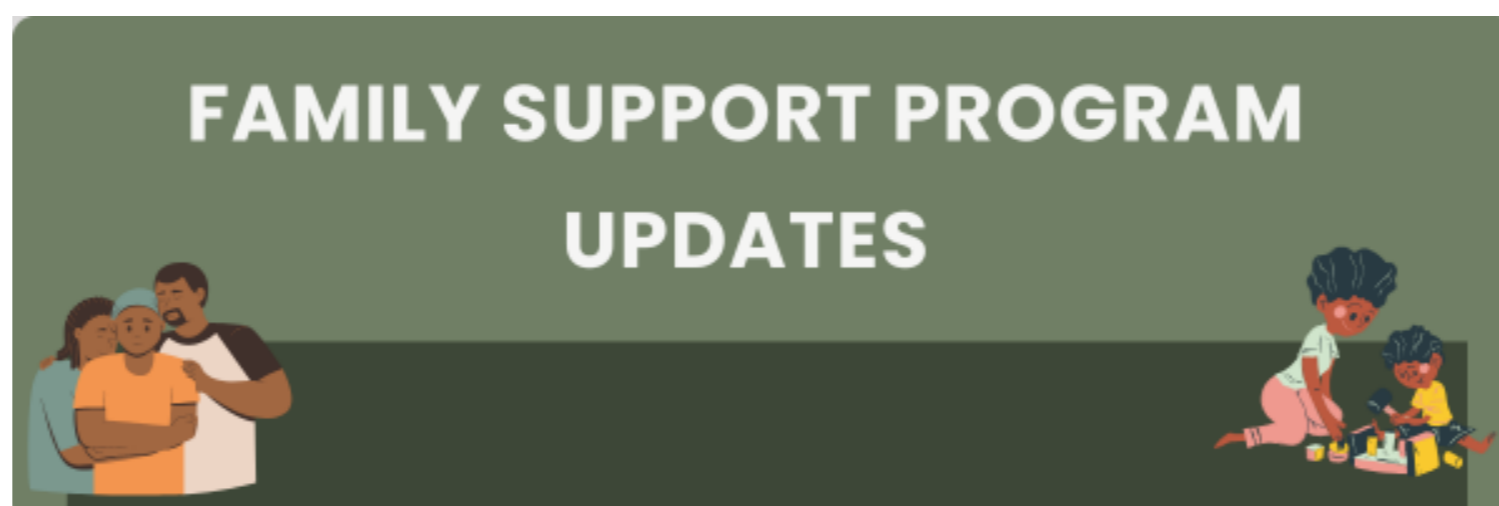
- Babies born in April: 9

April's birth numbers were higher than expected, as this is typically a quieter period. There was also one emergency transfer requiring an urgent C-section. When the family couldn't cover the cost, OTP stepped in without hesitation. Both mother and baby are now safe and recovering well. Your support allows us to answer those calls and say yes when it matters most. The photo on the left shows a room full of expectant mothers during one of our regular Thursday prenatal classes—another reminder that this work is made possible by you.
