The River’s Edge Ultra was a huge success, with 437 participants registered across distances ranging from kids’ 3k and 5k runs to the challenging 100-mile race. The first 100-miler finished in 23 hours 47 minutes, and the last crossed the line at 32 hours 39 minutes. This incredible event raised much-needed funds to support Olive Tree Projects’ work with mothers, children, and families in Haiti. A heartfelt thank you to the organizers and every runner who made this possible — your dedication on the trails is making a lasting impact in Jacmel.

Record broken again!

September was even busier at our midwifery center — we broke our clinic’s record once again, welcoming **21** babies! This comes just one month after setting our previous record in August with 15 births. The growing demand shows how essential our services are, but with funds running low, we need your support to keep saying “yes” to mothers who come through our doors.



Our Family Support Program (FSP) currently supports 14 families. Two are preparing to graduate once transition plans are in place, and one older participant has felt ready to move forward and live independently. We’ve also started psychological support for six young adults from our former foster program, each beginning a series of 13 sessions to help strengthen their mental health and resilience.
