FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAM UPDATES

Our Family Support Program (FSP) currently supports 14 families. Two are preparing to graduate once transition plans are in place, and one older participant has felt ready to move forward and live independently. We've also started psychological support for six young adults from our former foster program, each beginning a series of 13 sessions to help strengthen their mental health and resilience.
