### Birth & Patient Registration Update:

- Babies born in March: **6\***
- New patients: **43**

While March birth numbers appear lower, this reflects a higher number of transfers when mothers needed hospital care for the safest possible outcome, including cases such as high blood pressure, twin pregnancy, and labors that were not progressing. Safety always comes first, and our team walks with mothers through the transfer process while continuing their postpartum care with us afterward. The photo on the left shows a family who came for their postpartum check-up this month; the husband is a doctor at Life Ansanm Hospital, a valued partner where we often collaborate on seminars and where our sister birth center was once based.

## FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAM UPDATES

Our Family Support Program has launched a pilot after-school project to help support the academic success of the children in the 13 families we serve. Beginning with its first session on March 30, the program runs from 2–5 p.m. three times a week, offering homework help, extra academic support, a hot meal, and leisure activities to keep children mentally and physically engaged. We hope to find continued support for this project so we can keep investing in the children's academic success and continue meeting a need expressed by families.
