December’s Grim Reality: A Call for Support

This December has been a difficult month for many in our community, and two heartbreaking stories remind us of the urgent need for support.

On December 19th, a young girl in our Family Support Program was tragically raped while running an errand in her impoverished neighborhood. Devastated, her family turned to OTP for help, and we acted quickly—getting her medical treatment, supporting her through police reports, and connecting her with *Fanm Desidé*, an NGO offering support including legal for sexual assault victims. This young girl’s journey to healing is just beginning, and we are committed to standing by her side.

In another painful story, an 18-year-old young woman from Port-au-Prince came to us eight months pregnant, HIV-positive, and displaced after a violent gang attack. With no contact with her family, she faced an uncertain future. OTP immediately provided medical care, ensured she began antiretroviral medication, and facilitated her prenatal care. Early on December 30th, with the assistance of our midwives, she delivered a baby girl. Now, as she begins motherhood without the support of her family, we are working to include her and her newborn in our Family Support Program to provide the care and stability they need to thrive.
