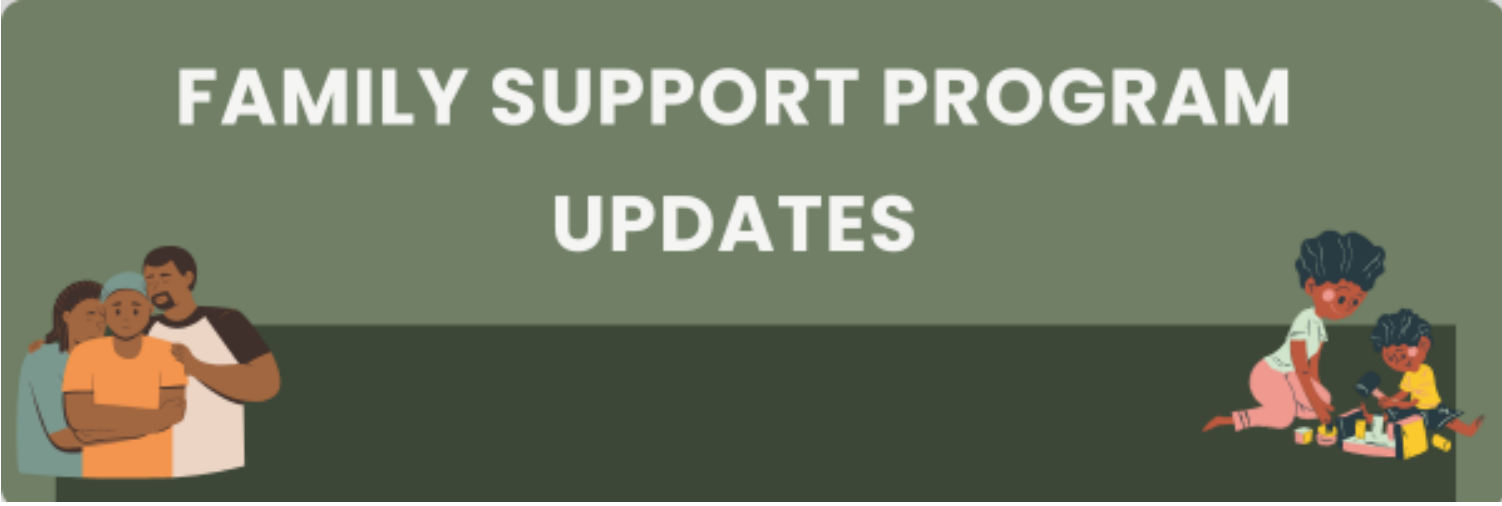
A Record Month of Births

Our midwives worked around the clock to support mothers and babies, including three born back-to-back on August 25th. This achievement is thanks to their dedication and the generosity of our donors. Our head midwife led another round of training on our electronic patient record database with the full team of midwives. The system has been customized to match their paper records, making the transition smoother and more intuitive. With the prenatal section now complete, we’re continuing to develop the birth, newborn, and family planning portions. It’s exciting to see the team gaining confidence with this tool, which not only modernizes our record-keeping but also helps ensure mothers and families receive more seamless, reliable care.



Our Family Support Program (FSP) currently supports 18 families, and this month we’re highlighting Jean Louis. He recently returned home after a month-long internship in the outskirts of Les Cayes. Jean Louis shared with our team how happy he was to be back, while reflecting on how much he enjoyed providing healthcare in hard-to-reach communities. He described it as a meaningful experience that will help shape his future career in nursing.
