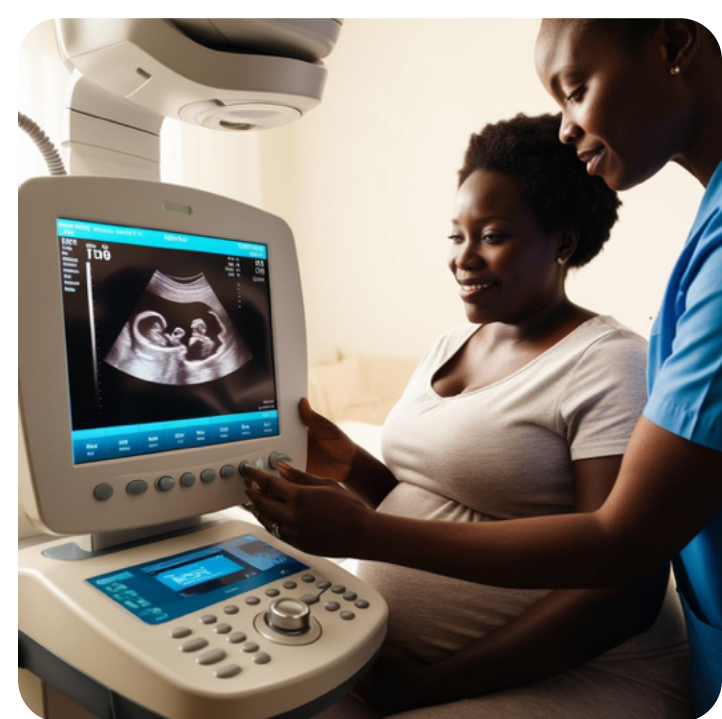
Dear <<First Name>> ,

They delivered at a hospital due to complications linked to multiples in pregnancy but stayed with us throughout pregnancy for the exceptional prenatal care we offer. After birth, they returned for postnatal classes.
