1. The Ministry of Beyond The Storm

A DISASTER RELIEF MINISTRY

We are a volunteer Disaster Relief Ministry and committed to taking the Light and Hope of Jesus Christ to people in need. These needs arise primarily as a result of natural disasters like floods, tornadoes, hurricanes, fires or ice. However, we also seek to respond to those who have other needs that can be met by our willingness to be the hands and feet of Jesus.

We are committed to frequently and consistently deploying teams of volunteers to places of need either locally in Pinellas County, FL, across the greater Florida area or across state lines within 1500 miles from our home base based in Seminole, FL.

A unique feature of a Beyond The Storm deployment is our commitment to intentional, personal, spiritual growth and study of The Word while deployed.

2. The Ministry of Habitat for Missions BUILDING SUPPORT FOR GOD'S GLOBAL WORK

Missionaries and ministries serving God around the world typically rely on the generosity of donors for financial support. But raising needed funds through this traditional method has become increasingly difficult. Habitat for Missions (HFM) addresses this need by providing a new revenue source for missions and ministry support.

This is done by partnering with local churches and organizations on house renovation projects: HFM buys a distressed house and the materials and products needed for renovation, and the partner church or organization provides the volunteer work force. When the house is sold, 90 percent of the profit is donated to support one or more missionaries or ministries designated by the partner.

Since HFM's founding in 2005, this exciting new source of financial support for missions and ministries has generated profits of more than \$1.5 million through 55 projects, benefiting missionaries and ministries in Africa, Asia, Australia, Europe, North America and South America.
