This ceramic tile represents an evolutionary step in ceramic technology as it has the flexural and fracture toughness of the inexpensive Alumina Oxide tile, but the hardness rivaling Boron Carbide without the stiff price point.

The net result is a Hexar product that is thinner and as light as Boron Carbide in comparable applications, but tough like Alumina Oxide. No longer do we need to offer tiers of performance by cost. One ceramic, Two ballistic systems, and one tried and true style, the San Diego concealable cut.

Here's how the buyback program works:

- 1. We have customers dating back to early 2015, and for any Hexar product we sold that is more than 5 years old you can apply a 15% trade in allowance for a new similar class product.
- 2. For customers that have Hexar that is 2 5 years from the purchase date we offer a 25% trade in allowance for similar class product
- 3. For customers who purchased in the last 2-years you can apply a 40% trade in allowance

Additionally, if you act before July 12th, 2024, you can also use our MILSPEC law enforcement discount for another 10% discount.

FAQ's:

Question: What if I bought a Flex Plate but I want the new Sand Diego Style Hexar, it says the trade in value is for similar class products that we originally purchased?

Answer: Whatever the amount is, you can apply it to whatever new Hexar TiB2 product you want! We sell the new product as a package and ala carte.

Question: How do I order?

Answer: This transaction requires a phone conversation or email exchange to validate your product with our records, and establish the trade in value, and a discussion of what product you wish to apply it towards. Once that's done, we will send you a payment link for the net amount, and when we are 1 week from shipping, we will send you a shipping label to send the old Hexar back. Once received we will ship the new generation Hexar.

Question: This seems too good to be true, why are you 'all doing this?

Answer: This does two things that are vitally important for a small business to grow, 1. It rewards past customers that supported us the ability to manufacture the newest and best armor we can make, and 2. It gives us the opportunity to do surveillance testing on old models to gain intelligence on how they age. Thus far we have had two cycles of Hexar, and the ones we have brought back so far have held up well, but increasing the sample size is always a good idea.

Stealth Armor Systems has the earliest filing date for flexible rifle armor of this concept, and we make it here in the United States. What does that mean? To us it means that we get up everyday, we buy the components, transfer adhesive films, and textile roll goods, and then we cut them, process them, assemble them, and do all the fit and finish work here in Missouri City, Texas with U.S. Citizens. This definition varies from the FTC's version of what Made in The USA means, their version is for duty to FTA countries (Free Trade Agreement) where it must have virtually every single molecule of the ingredients made in the USA as well. The TiB2 tile is an offshore innovation from an FTA country and that means we don't use Chinese products, and as far as all the other materials they are from the USA and we only use U.S. Citizens to build the product here in Texas!
