HUGE NEWS from our friends at Tucson Electric Power!

Through a generous grant from Tucson Electric Power, we will be completing a long-needed Trails Project early in 2020.

In addition to mapping and surveying our very popular hiking trails, we will be funding the full restoration of all upslope trails that were badly damaged by erosion in the 2018 floods. Social trails (unstructured trails caused by "bushwhacking") that are causing erosion damage will be identified and closed for visitor safety, trail sustainability and habitat restoration.

The project will include new signage on site for visitors to plan and navigate their hike and to learn about our mission at Sanctuary Cove.

In May, Bat Conservation International and a group of wonderful Cub Scouts helped us plant 26 agave pups which will help the endangered lesser long-nose bat. The tiny bat feeds exclusively on the fruit and nectar of night-blooming cacti including saguaro and organ pipe, as well as many species of agave. Planting these agave will help these important pollinators survive during migration.

In 1988 these bats were listed as endangered by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife service. Maternity roost disturbance and effects of habitat loss are the primary threats for these bats. Sanctuary Cove is planning another agave pup event with BCI for the spring; we hope you will look for notifications and get involved for our tiny, furry, flying friends!

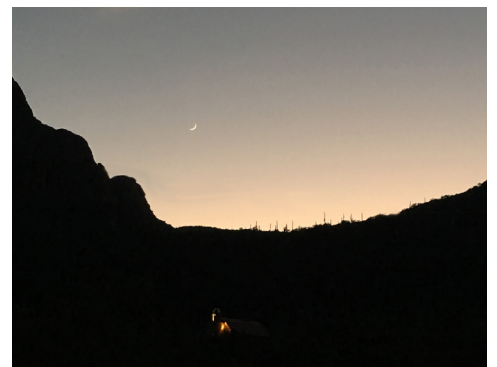

Also, NEW for 2020, we will open our amazing Labyrinth for full moon meditation once per month. Watch our website and Facebook pages for ticket information.



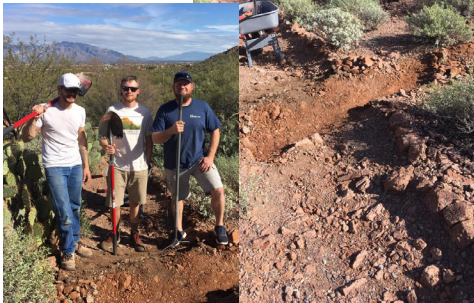

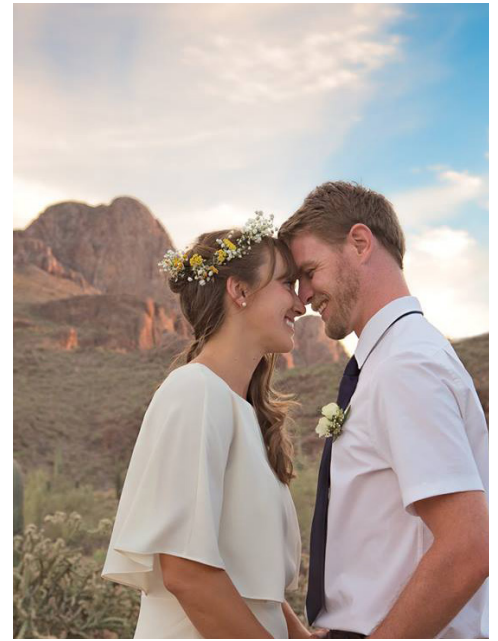
