My name is Sean. I am 50 years old and I'm from Warner Robins, Georgia. At an early age I was introduced to alcohol. Alcoholism had a deep hold on members of my family. I tried my best to stay away from it, but in my mid 30s I started drinking hard liquor along with using various other drugs. It caught hold of me so fiercely that I began falling into a very dark and hurtful world full of anger and loneliness.

I believed in God but wasn't living for Him. I was a rebellious, prideful, undisciplined and chaotic individual. I became a master at justifying my actions while having no intention of taking responsibility for them.

Over 20 years of alcohol and drug abuse brought a lifestyle engulfed with fear, depression and no self-control. I suffered the loss of family, friends, relationships and the loss of myself. After numerous encounters with the law, I cried out to God to end this and set me free. With my life completely broken, I reached out to my sister. She introduced me to a Christian man who told me about Adult & Teen Challenge of the Smokies Men's Center.

There were legal issues that needed to be dealt with first. I returned to Georgia to face my past. After 30 days in jail, I was able to come back and begin this brand new walk at Adult & Teen Challenge of the Smokies Men's Center.

Facing my past was the worst and best thing to ever happened. I am beginning to understand who I am in Christ. Walls are being torn down and a solid foundation is being built to help me be the man God intended me to be.

Matthew 11:29-30 is my life verse. Take My yoke upon you and learn of Me. For I am needy and lowly in heart and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.
