I am learning how to have joy and peace. I can invest my time and money toward the future as well as for eternity. On June 25, I was baptized in the Cullasaja River and began my walk with the Lord. I'm still new at this and I'm learning daily how to successfully walk as a Christian. I believe it will be a life long journey, and only with the help of God will I be able to do it. All my thanks goes to the Lord for what He has done in my life and who He has placed in my life. I am thankful for new beginnings and a favorable future. I want to thank all those who prayed for me and all those who have helped me to see that there is a better way to live and a better foundation to stand on.
