- Light weight; only 26 oz.
- Large hitting surface.

- Hit fly balls, grounders, and line-drives with ease.
- Increase practice efficiency with consistent and accurate ball placement.
- Hit balls as far as 200 feet with minimal effort.
- Can be used with baseballs, softballs, tennis balls and wiffle balls.
- Customizable for most team colors.
- Rebuildable components.
- 1 year warranty on all components.
- Can also be used to hit tennis balls for playing fetch with your furry friends.

RacketBat SAFETY

- Always know your surroundings while using the RacketBat.
- Never swing the RacketBat too close to any person or property.
- Never let go of the RacketBat while swinging or using the RacketBat.
- Never use the RacketBat for anything other than a practice tool.
- Never hit the RacketBat against anything other than approved balls.
- Always keep a good firm grip on the handle while using the RacketBat.
- Never use the RacketBat like or as a regular bat.
- Never hit an actual pitched ball with the RacketBat.
- Approved balls to use with the RacketBat are as follows.
 - 1. Baseball
 - 2. Softball
 - 3. Tennis ball
 - 4. Wiffle ball

RacketBat CARE

- Use only soapy water to clean the RacketBat.
- Never use a hot source to dry the RacketBat.
- Make sure the RacketBat is dry before storing it away.
- Never store sharp objects on top of or under the RacketBat.
- Never leave the RacketBat under direct sun contact for long periods of time.
- Excessive ball impact on the elastic tubing and frame can cause damage to these components.



Avoid ball impact in-between red areas.



Desired impact inside red circle.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

Point front shoulder at target, as seen in image.



Grip RacketBat with a good firm grip using the standard or modified grip, as seen in images.





Best for Fly Balls:

Swing the RacketBat from behind your back hip like an underhand-style throw. Follow through should be in an upward motion, as seen in image below.



Best for Grounders & Line-drives:

Swing RacketBat in a forward horizontal motion from your back hip towards the ground. Follow through should be towards the ground, or directly at target level, as seen in image below.



Drop the ball onto the RacketBat while forward swinging, as seen in image below.



A good placement of the ball in the middle of the net will give you a desired straight trajectory and will prolong the life of the net and RacketBat components.

Change the speed of your swing to control the distance of your ball placement.

YOU SHOULD ALWAYS PRACTICE WITH YOUR RACKETBAT WHEN YOU FIRST RECEIVE IT TO GET FAMILIAR WITH HOW IT WORKS BEFORE USING IT IN LIVE PRACTICE.
